Ezekiel 13:14... And I will tear down the wall that you men have plastered with whitewash and bring it into contact with the earth, and its foundation must be exposed. And she<sup>1</sup> will certainly fall, and you must come to an end in the midst of her, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah.
