Ezekiel 13:17... And as for you, O Son of Man, set your face against the daughters of your people who are acting as prophetesses out of their own heart, and prophesy against them.

[9] - References:

- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and you may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (Psalms 2:12)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- Son of man, set your face in the direction of the southern quarter and drip words to the south, and prophesy to the forest of the field of the south (Ezekiel 20:46)
- Son of man, set your face toward Jerusalem and drip words toward the holy places, and prophesy against the soil of Israel. (Ezekiel 21:2)
- And Miriam the prophetess, Aaron's sister, proceeded to take a tambourine in her hand, and all the women began going out with her with tambourines and in dances. (Exodus 15:20)
- Accordingly Hilkiah the priest and Ahikam and Achbor and Shaphan and Asaiah went to Huldah the prophetess the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah the son of Harhas, the caretaker of the garments, as she was dwelling in Jerusalem in the second quarter, and they proceeded to speak to her. (2 Kings 22:14)
- Now there was Anna a prophetess, Phanuel's daughter, of Asher's tribe, this woman was well along in years, and had lived with a husband for seven years from her virginity. (Luke 2:36)
- Nevertheless, I do hold this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and misleads my slaves to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols. (Revelation 2:20)
- Do remember, O my God, Tobiah and Sanballat, according to these deeds of each one, and also Noadiah the prophetess and

the rest of the prophets that were continually trying to make me afraid. (Nehemiah 6:14)
