who are prophesying, and you must say to those prophesying out of their own heart, Hear the word of Yehowah.

[16] - References:

- Concerning that day and hour nobody knows, neither the angels of the heavens nor the Son, but only the Father. (Matthew 24:36)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. (Matthew 24:42)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the words of the prophets who are prophesying to you people. They are making you become vain. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:16)
- They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me; Yehowah has spoken; Peace is what you people will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his heart they have said; No calamity will come upon you people. (Jeremiah 23:17)
- For who has stood in the intimate group of Yehowah that he might see and hear his word? Who has given attention to his word that he might hear it? (Jeremiah 23:18)
- I did not send the prophets, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (Jeremiah 23:21)
- But if they had stood in my intimate group, then they would have made my people hear my own words, and they would have caused them to turn back from their bad way and from the badness of their dealings. (Jeremiah 23:22)
- This is what Yehowah has said against the prophets that are causing my people to wander, that are biting with their teeth and that actually call out; Peace! That, when anyone does not put something into their mouths, also actually sanctify war against him. (Micah 3:5)

- Her prophets were insolent, were men of treachery. Her priests themselves profaned what was holy, they did violence to the Law. (Zephaniah 3:4)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among You. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (2 Peter 2:1)
- And Yehowah went on to say to me; Falsehood is what the prophets are prophesying in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their heart they are speaking prophetically to you people. (Jeremiah 14:14)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the words of the prophets who are prophesying to you people. They are making you become vain. The vision of their own heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:16)
- And now hear the word of Yehowah, Are you saying; You must not prophesy against Israel, and you must let no word drop against the house of Isaac? (Amos 7:16)
- In case a prophet or a dreamer of a dream arises in your midst and does give you a sign or a portent. (Deuteronomy 13:1)
- And a certain old prophet was dwelling in Bethel, and his sons now came in and related to him all the work that the man of the true God had done that day in Bethel and the words that he had spoken to the king, and they went on relating them to their father. (1 Kings 13:11)
- Now the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah were sitting each one on his throne, clothed in garments, in the threshing floor at the entrance of the gate of Samaria, and all the prophets were acting as prophets before them. (1 Kings 22:10)
- Therefore here I am against the prophets, is the utterance of Yehowah, the ones who are stealing away my words, each one from his companion. (Jeremiah 23:30)
- Your own prophets have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things. And they have not uncovered your error in

- order to turn back your captivity. But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (Lamentations 2:14)
- Therefore, O prostitute, hear the word of Yehowah. (Ezekiel 16:35)
- Woe to my valueless shepherd, who is leaving the flock! A sword will be upon his arm and upon his right eye. His own arm will without fail dry up, and his own right eye will without fail grow dim. (Zechariah 11:17)
