

**Ezekiel 13:2** **Son of Man, prophesy concerning the prophets of Israel who are prophesying, and you must say to those prophesying out of their own heart, Hear the word of Yehowah.**

[16] - References:

- Concerning that day and hour nobody knows, neither the angels of the heavens nor the Son, but only the Father. (**Matthew 24:36**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **YOU** do not know on what day **YOUR** Lord is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the **words** of the **prophets** who are **prophesying** to **YOU** people. They are making **YOU** become vain. The vision of their **own heart** is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:16**)
- They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me; Yehowah has spoken; Peace is what **YOU** people will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his **heart** they have said; No calamity will come upon **YOU** people. (**Jeremiah 23:17**)
- For who has stood in the intimate group of Yehowah that he might see and hear his **word**? Who has given attention to his **word** that he might hear it? (**Jeremiah 23:18**)
- I did not send the **prophets**, yet they themselves ran. I did not speak to them, yet they themselves prophesied. (**Jeremiah 23:21**)
- But if they had stood in my intimate group, then they would have made my people hear my **own words**, and they would have caused them to turn back from their bad way and from the badness of their dealings. (**Jeremiah 23:22**)
- This is what Yehowah has said against the **prophets** that are causing my people to wander, that are biting with their teeth and that actually call **out**; Peace! That, when anyone does not put something into their mouths, also actually sanctify war against him. (**Micah 3:5**)

- Her **prophets** were insolent, were men of treachery. Her priests themselves profaned what was holy, they did violence to the Law. (**Zephaniah 3:4**)
- However, there also came to be false **prophets** among the people, as there will also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
- And Yehowah went on to **say** to me; Falsehood is what the **prophets** are **prophesying** in my name. I have not sent them, nor have I commanded them or spoken to them. A false vision and divination and a valueless thing and the trickiness of their **heart** they are speaking prophetically to **you** people. (**Jeremiah 14:14**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Do not listen to the **words** of the **prophets** who are **prophesying** to **you** people. They are making **you** become vain. The vision of their **own heart** is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:16**)
- And now hear the **word** of Yehowah, Are you saying; You **must** not **prophesy** against **Israel**, and you **must** let no **word** drop against the house of Isaac? (**Amos 7:16**)
- In case a prophet or a dreamer of a dream arises in your midst and does give you a sign or a portent. (**Deuteronomy 13:1**)
- And a certain old prophet was dwelling in Bethel, and his sons now came in and related to him all the work that the man of the true God had done that day in Bethel and the **words** that he had spoken to the king, and they went on relating them to their father. (**1 Kings 13:11**)
- Now the king of **Israel** and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah were sitting each one on his throne, clothed in garments, in the threshing floor at the entrance of the gate of Samaria, and all the **prophets** were acting as **prophets** before them. (**1 Kings 22:10**)
- Therefore here I am against the **prophets**, is the utterance of Yehowah, the ones who are stealing away my **words**, each one from his companion. (**Jeremiah 23:30**)
- Your **own prophets** have visioned for you worthless and unsatisfying things. And they have not uncovered your error in

- order to turn back your captivity. But they kept visioning for you worthless and misleading pronouncements. (**Lamentations 2:14**)
- Therefore, O prostitute, hear the **word** of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 16:35**)
  - Woe to my valueless shepherd, who is leaving the flock! A sword will be upon his arm and upon his right eye. His **own** arm will without fail dry up, and his **own** right eye will without fail grow dim. (**Zechariah 11:17**)
