- For rebelliousness is the same as the sin of divination, and pushing ahead presumptuously the same as using uncanny power and teraphim. Since you **have** rejected the word of Yehowah, he accordingly rejects you from being king. (**1 Samuel 15:23**)
- He that is trusting in his **own** heart is **stupid**, but he that is **walking** in wisdom is the one that will escape. (**Proverbs 28:26**)
- And so I let them go in the stubbornness of their heart, they went **walking** in their **own** counsels. (**Psalms 81:12**)
- Here I am against the **prophets** of false dreams, is the utterance of Yehowah, who relate them and cause my people to wander about because of their falsehoods and because of their boasting. But I myself did not send them or command them. So they will by no means benefit this people, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:32**)
- And now send, collect together all Israel to me at Mount Carmel and also the four hundred and fifty **prophets** of Baal and the four hundred **prophets** of the sacred pole, who are eating at the table of Jezebel. (**1 Kings 18:19**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies **has said**; Do not listen to the words of the **prophets** who are prophesying to **you** people. They are making **you** become vain. The vision of their **own** heart is what they speak, not from the mouth of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 23:16**)
- And do not listen to the words of the **prophets** that are saying to **you** men, **you** will not serve the king of Babylon, because falsehood is what they are prophesying to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:14**)
- For I **have** not sent them, is the utterance of Yehowah, but they are prophesying in my name falsely, to the end that I shall

- disperse **you**, and **you** will **have** to perish, **you** men and the **prophets** that are prophesying to **you**. (**Jeremiah 27:15**)
- And Jeremiah the prophet went on to say to Hananiah the prophet; Listen, please, O Hananiah! Yehowah **has** not sent you, but you yourself **have** caused this people to trust in a falsehood. (**Jeremiah 28:15**)
 - Her gates **have** sunk down into the very earth. He **has** destroyed and broken her bars in pieces. Her king and her princes are among the nations. There is no Law. Her **own prophets** also **have** found no vision from Yehowah. (**Lamentations 2:9**)
 - If a man, **walking** by wind and falsehood, **has** told the lie; I shall let words drop to you concerning wine and concerning intoxicating liquor, he also will certainly become the one letting words drop for this people. (**Micah 2:11**)
