

**Ezekiel 13:4** Like foxes in the devastated places are what your own prophets have become, O Israel.

[7] - References:

- If, though, despite these things, **you** will not listen to me, I shall then **have** to chastise **you** seven times as much for **your** sins. (**Leviticus 26:18**)
- And I shall **have** to break the pride of **your** strength and make **your** heavens like iron and **your** earth like copper. (**Leviticus 26:19**)
- And **your** power will simply be expended for nothing, as **your** earth will not give its yield, and the tree of the earth will not give its fruit. (**Leviticus 26:20**)
- But if **you** keep walking in opposition to me and not wishing to listen to me, I shall then **have** to inflict seven times more blows upon **you** according to **your** sins. (**Leviticus 26:21**)
- And I will send the wild beasts of the field among **you**, and they will certainly bereave **you** of children and cut off **your** domestic animals and reduce the number of **you**, and **your** roads will actually be desolated. (**Leviticus 26:22**)
- Nevertheless, if with these things **you** do not let yourselves be corrected by me and **you** just **have** to walk in opposition to me. (**Leviticus 26:23**)
- And he continued saying to me; Son of man, here I am breaking the rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended, in Jerusalem, and they will **have** to eat bread by weight and in anxious care, and it will be by measure and in horror that they will drink water itself. (**Ezekiel 4:16**)
- When I send the injurious arrows of the famine upon them, which must prove to be for ruination, which arrows I shall send to bring **you** people to ruin, even famine I shall increase upon **you** people and I will break **your** rods around which ring-shaped loaves are suspended. (**Ezekiel 5:16**)
- Do **you** people grab hold of the foxes for us, the little foxes that are making spoil of the vineyards, as our vineyards are abloom. (**Song of Solomon 2:15**)

- **But because of the false brothers brought in quietly, who sneaked in to spy upon our freedom which we **have** in union with Christ Jesus, that they might completely enslave us. (**Galatians 2:4**)**
- **In order that we should no longer be babes, tossed about as by waves and carried hither and thither by every wind of teaching by means of the trickery of men, by means of cunning in contriving error. (**Ephesians 4:14**)**
- **On account of Zion's mountain that is desolated, foxes themselves **have** walked on it. (**Lamentations 5:18**)**
