- When I say to someone wicked; You **will** positively die, and you do not actually warn him and speak in order to warn the wicked one from his wicked way to preserve him alive, he being wicked, in his **error** he **will** die, but his blood I shall ask back from your own hand. (**Ezekiel 3:18**)
- And likewise even the males left the natural use of the female and became violently inflamed in their lust toward one another, males with males, working what is obscene and receiving in themselves the full recompense, which was due for their **error**. (**Romans 1:27**)
- And the very people to whom they are prophesying **will** become people cast out into the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword, with no one to do the burying of them, them, their wives and their sons and their daughters. And I **will** pour out upon them their calamity. (**Jeremiah 14:16**)
- The days of being given attention must come, the days of the due payment must come. Those of Israel **will** know it. The **prophet will** be foolish, the man of inspired expression **will** be maddened on account of the abundance of your **error**, even animosity being abundant. (**Hosea 9:7**)
