

Ezekiel 14:20 **Even were Noah, Daniel and Job in the midst of it, as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, neither son nor daughter would they deliver, they themselves because of their righteousness would deliver their soul.**

[10] - References:

- After that Yehowah said to **Noah**; Go, you and all your household, into the ark, because you are the one I have seen to be righteous before me among this generation. (**Genesis 7:1**)
- Look! You are wiser than **Daniel**. There are no secrets that have proved a match for you. (**Ezekiel 28:3**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to Satan; Have you set your heart upon my servant **Job**, that there is no one like him in the earth, a man blameless and upright, fearing God and turning aside from bad? (**Job 1:8**)
- And now take for yourselves seven bulls and seven rams and go to my servant **Job**, and **you** men must offer up a burnt sacrifice in **YOUR** own behalf, and **Job** my servant will himself pray for **you**. His face only I shall accept so as not to commit disgraceful folly with **you**, for **you** have not spoken concerning me what is truthful, as has my servant Job. (**Job 42:8**)
- And had these three men proved to be in the **midst** of it, **Noah**, **Daniel** and **Job**, they themselves because of their **righteousness** would **deliver** their soul, is the **utterance** of the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 14:14**)
- The **soul** that is sinning, it itself will die. A **son** himself will bear nothing because of the error of the father, and a father himself will bear nothing because of the error of the **son**. Upon his own self the very **righteousness** of the righteous one will come to be, and upon his own self the very wickedness of a wicked one will come to be. (**Ezekiel 18:20**)
- Sow seed for yourselves in **righteousness**, reap in accord with loving-kindness. Till for yourselves arable land, when there is time for searching for Yehowah until he comes and gives instruction in **righteousness** to **you**. (**Hosea 10:12**)
- Seek Yehowah, all **you** meek ones of the earth, who have practiced His own judicial decision. Seek **righteousness**, seek

meekness. Probably **you** may be concealed in the day of Yehowah's anger. (**Zephaniah 2:3**)

- There happened to be a man in the land of Uz whose name was **Job**, and that man proved to be blameless and upright, and fearing God and turning aside from bad. (**Job 1:1**)
