Ezekiel 14:23... And they will certainly comfort you people when you see their way and their dealings, and you will have to know that it was not without cause that I shall have done all that I must do against her, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah.

- And you, O son of man, do not be afraid of them, and of their words do not be afraid, because there are obstinate ones and things pricking you and it is among scorpions that you are dwelling. Of their words do not you be afraid, and at their faces do not you be struck with terror, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 2:6)
- Consequently Yehowah said; The cry of complaint about Sodom and Gomorrah, yes, it is loud, and their sin, yes, it is very heavy. (Genesis 18:20)
- And you are righteous as regards all that has come upon us, for faithfully is how you have acted, but we are the ones that have done wickedly. (Nehemiah 9:33)
- And they will have to say; On account of the fact that they left the covenant of Yehowah their God and proceeded to bow down to other gods and to serve them. (Jeremiah 22:9)
