

Ezekiel 14:4 **Therefore speak with them and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Any man at all¹ of the house of Israel that brings up his dungy idols upon his heart and that places the very stumbling block causing his error in front of his face and that actually comes to the prophet, I, Yehowah, I will let myself be brought to answer him in the matter according to the multitude of his dungy idols.**

- The wise ones have become ashamed. They have become terrified and **will** be caught. Look! They have rejected the very word of Yehowah, and **what** wisdom do they have? (**Jeremiah 8:9**)
- Therefore here I am, the One that **will** act wonderfully again with this people, in a wonderful manner and with something wonderful, and the wisdom of their wise men **must** perish, and the very understanding of their discreet men **will** conceal itself. (**Isaiah 29:14**)
- I know that after my going away oppressive wolves **will** enter in among **you** and **will** not treat the flock with tenderness. (**Acts of Apostles 20:29**)
- And from among **you** yourselves men **will** rise and speak twisted things to draw away the disciples after themselves. (**Acts of Apostles 20:30**)
- Sanctify them by means of the truth, your word is truth. (**John 17:17**)
- Therefore, when **you** catch sight of the disgusting thing that causes desolation, as spoken of through Daniel the **prophet**, standing in a holy place, **let** the reader use discernment. (**Matthew 24:15**)
- Then **let** those in Judea begin fleeing to the mountains. (**Matthew 24:16**)
- And **YOUR** altars **must** be made desolate and **YOUR** incense stands **must** be broken, and I **will** cause **YOUR** slain ones to fall before **YOUR dungy idols**. (**Ezekiel 6:4**)

- Then he spoke to him; This is **what** Yehowah **has said**, For the reason that you have sent messengers to inquire of Baal-zebub the god of Ekron, is it because there is no God at all in **Israel** of whose word to inquire? Therefore as regards the couch upon which you have gone up, you **will** not come down off it, because you **will** positively die. (**2 Kings 1:16**)
- I myself, in turn, shall choose ways of ill-treating them, and the things frightful to them I shall bring upon them, for the reason that I called, but there was no one answering, I spoke, but there were none that listened, and they kept on doing **what** was bad in my eyes, and the thing in which I took no delight they chose. (**Isaiah 66:4**)
- For any **man** at all from the **house** of **Israel** or from the alien residents that reside as aliens in **Israel**, that withdraws himself from following me and that **brings** up his **dungy idols** upon his **heart** and that sets the very **stumbling block** causing his **error** in **front** of his **face** and that **actually comes** to the **prophet** to make inquiry for himself by me, I, Yehowah, I am letting myself be **brought** to **answer** him by myself. (**Ezekiel 14:7**)
- And you proceeded to take some of your garments and make for yourself high **places** of varied colors and you would prostitute yourself on them, such things are not coming in, and it should not happen. (**Ezekiel 16:16**)
- Will you judge them? Will you judge them, O son of **man**? Cause them to know the detestable things of their forefathers. (**Ezekiel 20:4**)
- For the reason that they rejected my own judicial decisions, and as regards my statutes, they did not walk in them, and my Sabbaths they profaned, because it was after their **dungy idols** that their **heart** was going. (**Ezekiel 20:16**)
