Ezekiel 15:2" Son of Man, in what way does the vine tree happen to be different from every other tree, the shoot, that has come to be among the trees of the forest?

- This is what Yehowah has said; Cursed is the able-bodied man who puts his trust in earthling man and actually makes flesh his arm, and whose heart turns away from Yehowah himself.

 (Jeremiah 17:5)
- And he will certainly become like a solitary tree in the desert plain and will not see when good comes, but he must reside in parched places in the wilderness, in a salt country that is not inhabited. (Jeremiah 17:6)
- Blessed is the able-bodied man who puts his trust in Yehowah, and whose confidence Yehowah has become. (Jeremiah 17:7)
- And he will certainly become like a tree planted by the waters, that sends out its roots right by the watercourse, and he will not see when heat comes, but his foliage will actually prove to be luxuriant. And in the year of drought he will not become anxious, nor will he leave off from producing fruit. (Jeremiah 17:8)
- Woe to those drawing error with ropes of untruth, and as with wagon cords sin. (Isaiah 5:18)
- Those who are saying; Let his work hasten, do let it come quickly, in order that we may see it, and let the counsel of the Holy One of Israel draw near and come, that we may know it! (Isaiah 5:19)
- Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (Isaiah 5:20)
- Woe to those wise in their own eyes and discreet even in front of their own faces! (Isaiah 5:21)
- Woe to those who are mighty in drinking wine, and to the men with vital energy for mixing intoxicating liquor. (Isaiah 5:22)

- Those who are pronouncing the wicked one righteous in consideration of a bribe, and who take away even the righteousness of the righteous one from him! (Isaiah 5:23)
- For their vine is from the vine of Sodom and from the terraces of Gomorrah. Their grapes are grapes of poison, their clusters are bitter. (Deuteronomy 32:32)
- You proceeded to make a vine depart from Egypt. You kept driving out the nations, that you might plant it. (Psalms 80:8)
- Let me sing, please, to my beloved one a song of my loved one concerning his vineyard. There was a vineyard that my beloved one came to have on a fruitful hillside. (Isaiah 5:1)
- Also, he started to speak to them with illustrations; A man planted a vineyard, and put a fence around it, and dug a vat for the winepress and erected a tower, and let it out to cultivators, and traveled abroad. (Mark 12:1)
- Your mother was like a vine in your blood, planted by waters. A bearer of fruit and full of branches she became because of abundant water. (Ezekiel 19:10)
