

Ezekiel 15:6 **Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Just like the vine tree among the trees of the forest, that I have given to the fire as fuel, so I have given the inhabitants of Jerusalem.**

- Finally the one that had received the one talent came forward and **said**, Master, I knew you to be an exacting man, reaping where you did not sow and gathering where you did not winnow. (**Matthew 25:24**)
- So I grew afraid and went off and hid your talent in the ground. Here you **have** what is yours. (**Matthew 25:25**)
- In reply his master **said** to him; Wicked and sluggish slave, you knew, did you, that I reaped where I did not sow and gathered where I did not winnow? (**Matthew 25:26**)
- Well, then, you ought to **have** deposited my silver monies with the bankers, and on my arrival I would be receiving what is mine with interest. (**Matthew 25:27**)
- Therefore **TAKE** away the talent from him and give it to him that **has** the ten talents. (**Matthew 25:28**)
- For to everyone that **has**, more will be **given** and he will **have** abundance, but as for him that does not **have**, even what he **has** will be taken away from him. (**Matthew 25:29**)
- And throw the good-for-nothing slave out into the darkness outside. There is where his weeping and the gnashing of his teeth will be. (**Matthew 25:30**)
- Then he will say, in turn, to those on his left, Be on **YOUR** way from me, **YOU** who **have** been cursed, into the everlasting **fire** prepared for the Devil and his angels. (**Matthew 25:41**)
- For I became hungry, but **YOU** gave me nothing to eat, and I got thirsty, but **YOU** gave me nothing to drink. (**Matthew 25:42**)
- I was a stranger, but **YOU** did not receive me hospitably, naked, but **YOU** did not clothe me, sick and in prison, but **YOU** did not look after me. (**Matthew 25:43**)

- Then they also will answer with the words, Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison and did not minister to you? (**Matthew 25:44**)
- Then he will answer them with the words; Truly I say to **YOU**, to the extent that **YOU** did not do it to one of these least ones, **YOU** did not do it to me. (**Matthew 25:45**)
- And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (**Matthew 25:46**)
- Five of them were foolish, and five were discreet. (**Matthew 25:2**)
- For the foolish took their lamps but took no oil with them. (**Matthew 25:3**)
- Whereas the discreet took oil in their receptacles with their lamps. (**Matthew 25:4**)
- While the bridegroom was delaying, they all nodded and went to sleep. (**Matthew 25:5**)
- Right in the middle of the night there arose a cry, Here is the bridegroom! Be on **YOUR** way out to meet him. (**Matthew 25:6**)
- Then all those virgins rose and put their lamps in order. (**Matthew 25:7**)
- The foolish **said** to the discreet; Give us some of **YOUR** oil, because our lamps are about to go out. (**Matthew 25:8**)
- The discreet answered with the words; Perhaps there may not be quite enough for us and **YOU**. Be on **YOUR** way, instead, to those who sell it and buy for yourselves. (**Matthew 25:9**)
- While they were going off to buy, the bridegroom arrived, and the virgins that were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was shut. (**Matthew 25:10**)
- Do **YOU** not know that **YOU** people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in **you**? (**1 Corinthians 3:16**)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple **YOU** people are. (**1 Corinthians 3:17**)

- You will constitute them as a fiery furnace at the appointed time for your attention. Yehowah in his anger will swallow them up, and the **fire** will devour them. (**Psalms 21:9**)
- Son of man, to me those of the house of Israel **have** become as scummy dross. All of them are copper and tin and iron and lead in the midst of a furnace. Much scummy dross, that of silver, they **have** become. (**Ezekiel 22:18**)
- Therefore this is what the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah **has said**, For the reason that all of **you have** become as much scummy dross, therefore here I am collecting **you** together into the midst of **Jerusalem**. (**Ezekiel 22:19**)
- As in collecting silver and copper and iron and lead and tin into the midst of a furnace, in order to blow upon it with **fire** to cause a liquefying, so I shall collect them together in my anger and in my rage, and I will blow and cause **you** people to liquefy. (**Ezekiel 22:20**)
- And I will bring **you** together and blow upon **you** with the **fire** of my fury, and **you** must be liquefied in the midst of her. (**Ezekiel 22:21**)
- As in the liquefying of silver in the midst of a furnace, so **you** people will be liquefied in the midst of her, and **you** will **have** to know that I myself, Yehowah, **have** poured out my rage upon **you**. (**Ezekiel 22:22**)
- And they will pitch them into the fiery furnace. There is where their weeping and the gnashing of their teeth will be. (**Matthew 13:42**)
- And will cast them into the fiery furnace. There is where their weeping and the gnashing of their teeth will be. (**Matthew 13:50**)
- Therefore just as a tongue of **fire** eats up the stubble and into the flames mere dried grass sinks down, their very rootstock will become just like a musty smell, and their blossom itself will go up just like powder, because they **have** rejected the Law of Yehowah of armies, and the saying of the Holy One of Israel they **have** disrespected. (**Isaiah 5:24**)
- He **has** gone up as a lion out of his thicket, and the one who is bringing the nations to ruin **has** pulled away, he **has** gone forth from his place in order to render your land as an object of

astonishment. Your own cities will fall in ruins so that there will be no inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 4:7**)

- Therefore this is what the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said**, Look! My anger and my rage are being poured forth upon this place, upon mankind and upon domestic animal, and upon the **tree** of the field and upon the fruitage of the ground, and it must burn, and it will not be extinguished. (**Jeremiah 7:20**)
- And you must say to the **forest** of the south; Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said**; Here I am setting a **fire** ablaze against you, and it must devour in you every still-moist **tree** and every dry **tree**. The kindling flame will not be extinguished, and by it all faces must be scorched from the south to the north. (**Ezekiel 20:47**)
- When her sprigs **have** dried up, women coming in will break them off, lighting them up. For it is not a people of keen understanding. That is why its Maker will show it no mercy, and its own Former will show it no favor. (**Isaiah 27:11**)
- But she was finally uprooted in fury. To the earth she was thrown, and there was an east wind that dried up her fruit. Her strong rod was torn off and became dry. Fire itself devoured it. (**Ezekiel 19:12**)
- Israel is a degenerating **vine**. Fruit he keeps putting forth for himself. In proportion to the abundance of his fruit he **has** multiplied his altars. In proportion to the goodness of his land, they put up good pillars. (**Hosea 10:1**)
