Ezekiel 15:6" Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Just like the vine tree among the trees of the forest, that I have given to the fire as fuel, so I have given the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

- Finally the one that had received the one talent came forward and said, Master, I knew you to be an exacting man, reaping where you did not sow and gathering where you did not winnow. (Matthew 25:24)
- So I grew afraid and went off and hid your talent in the ground. Here you have what is yours. (Matthew 25:25)
- In reply his master said to him; Wicked and sluggish slave, you knew, did you, that I reaped where I did not sow and gathered where I did not winnow? (Matthew 25:26)
- Well, then, you ought to have deposited my silver monies with the bankers, and on my arrival I would be receiving what is mine with interest. (Matthew 25:27)
- Therefore TAKE away the talent from him and give it to him that has the ten talents. (Matthew 25:28)
- For to everyone that has, more will be given and he will have abundance, but as for him that does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him. (Matthew 25:29)
- And throw the good-for-nothing slave out into the darkness outside. There is where his weeping and the gnashing of his teeth will be. (Matthew 25:30)
- Then he will say, in turn, to those on his left, Be on YOUR way from me, YOU who have been cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the Devil and his angels. (Matthew 25:41)
- For I became hungry, but you gave me nothing to eat, and I got thirsty, but you gave me nothing to drink. (Matthew 25:42)
- I was a stranger, but you did not receive me hospitably, naked, but you did not clothe me, sick and in prison, but you did not look after me. (Matthew 25:43)

- Then they also will answer with the words, Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison and did not minister to you? (Matthew 25:44)
- Then he will answer them with the words; Truly I say to YOU, to the extent that YOU did not do it to one of these least ones, YOU did not do it to me. (Matthew 25:45)
- And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (Matthew 25:46)
- Five of them were foolish, and five were discreet. (Matthew 25:2)
- For the foolish took their lamps but took no oil with them. (Matthew 25:3)
- Whereas the discreet took oil in their receptacles with their lamps. (Matthew 25:4)
- While the bridegroom was delaying, they all nodded and went to sleep. (Matthew 25:5)
- Right in the middle of the night there arose a cry, Here is the bridegroom! Be on YOUR way out to meet him. (Matthew 25:6)
- Then all those virgins rose and put their lamps in order. (Matthew 25:7)
- The foolish said to the discreet; Give us some of YOUR oil, because our lamps are about to go out. (Matthew 25:8)
- The discreet answered with the words; Perhaps there may not be quite enough for us and you. Be on your way, instead, to those who sell it and buy for yourselves. (Matthew 25:9)
- While they were going off to buy, the bridegroom arrived, and the virgins that were ready went in with him to the marriage feast, and the door was shut. (Matthew 25:10)
- Do you not know that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple you people are. (1 Corinthians 3:17)

- You will constitute them as a fiery furnace at the appointed time for your attention. Yehowah in his anger will swallow them up, and the fire will devour them. (Psalms 21:9)
- Son of man, to me those of the house of Israel have become as scummy dross. All of them are copper and tin and iron and lead in the midst of a furnace. Much scummy dross, that of silver, they have become. (Ezekiel 22:18)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, For the reason that all of you have become as much scummy dross, therefore here I am collecting you together into the midst of Jerusalem. (Ezekiel 22:19)
- As in collecting silver and copper and iron and lead and tin into the midst of a furnace, in order to blow upon it with fire to cause a liquefying, so I shall collect them together in my anger and in my rage, and I will blow and cause YOU people to liquefy. (Ezekiel 22:20)
- And I will bring You together and blow upon You with the fire of my fury, and You must be liquefied in the midst of her. (Ezekiel 22:21)
- As in the liquefying of silver in the midst of a furnace, so you people will be liquefied in the midst of her, and you will have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have poured out my rage upon you. (Ezekiel 22:22)
- And they will pitch them into the fiery furnace. There is where their weeping and the gnashing of their teeth will be. (Matthew 13:42)
- And will cast them into the fiery furnace. There is where their weeping and the gnashing of their teeth will be. (Matthew 13:50)
- Therefore just as a tongue of fire eats up the stubble and into the flames mere dried grass sinks down, their very rootstock will become just like a musty smell, and their blossom itself will go up just like powder, because they have rejected the Law of Yehowah of armies, and the saying of the Holy One of Israel they have disrespected. (Isaiah 5:24)
- He has gone up as a lion out of his thicket, and the one who is bringing the nations to ruin has pulled away, he has gone forth from his place in order to render your land as an object of

- astonishment. Your own cities will fall in ruins so that there will be no inhabitant. (Jeremiah 4:7)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Look! My anger and my rage are being poured forth upon this place, upon mankind and upon domestic animal, and upon the tree of the field and upon the fruitage of the ground, and it must burn, and it will not be extinguished. (Jeremiah 7:20)
- And you must say to the forest of the south; Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am setting a fire ablaze against you, and it must devour in you every still-moist tree and every dry tree. The kindling flame will not be extinguished, and by it all faces must be scorched from the south to the north. (Ezekiel 20:47)
- When her sprigs have dried up, women coming in will break them off, lighting them up. For it is not a people of keen understanding. That is why its Maker will show it no mercy, and its own Former will show it no favor. (Isaiah 27:11)
- But she was finally uprooted in fury. To the earth she was thrown, and there was an east wind that dried up her fruit. Her strong rod was torn off and became dry. Fire itself devoured it. (Ezekiel 19:12)
- Israel is a degenerating vine. Fruit he keeps putting forth for himself. In proportion to the abundance of his fruit he has multiplied his altars. In proportion to the goodness of his land, they put up good pillars. (Hosea 10:1)
