have gone forth, but the fire itself will devour them. And you people will have to know that I am Yehowah, when I direct my face against them.

- This people honors me with their lips, yet their heart is far removed from me. (Matthew 15:8)
- And Yehowah says; For the reason that this people have come near with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their heart itself far away from me, and their fear toward me becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (Isaiah 29:13)
- Therefore here I am, the One that will act wonderfully again with this people, in a wonderful manner and with something wonderful, and the wisdom of their wise men must perish, and the very understanding of their discreet men will conceal itself. (Isaiah 29:14)
- A good tree cannot bear worthless fruit, neither can a rotten tree produce fine fruit. (Matthew 7:18)
- Every tree not producing fine fruit gets cut down and thrown into the fire. (Matthew 7:19)
- Really, then, by their fruits you will recognize those men. (Matthew 7:20)
- Not everyone saying to me; Lord, Lord, will enter into the kingdom of the heavens, but the one doing the will of my Father who is in the heavens will. (Matthew 7:21)
- Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and expel demons in your name, and perform many powerful works in your name? (Matthew 7:22)
- And yet then I will confess to them; I never knew You! Get away from me, You workers of lawlessness. (Matthew 7:23)

- As for any man of the house of Israel or some alien resident who is residing as an alien in YOUR midst who eats any sort of blood, I shall certainly set my face against the soul that is eating the blood, and I shall indeed cut him off from among his people. (Leviticus 17:10)
