Ezekiel 16:22... And in all your detestable things and your acts of prostitution you did not remember the days of your youth when you happened to be naked and nude, kicking about in your blood you happened to be.

- Look! Sons are an inheritance from Yehowah, the fruitage of the belly is a reward. (Psalms 127:3)
- Yes, he went so far as to say; When you help the Hebrew women to give birth and you do see them on the stool for childbirth, if it is a son, you must also put it to death, but if it is a daughter, it must also live. (Exodus 1:16)
- Go, and you must call out in the ears of Jerusalem, saying; This is what Yehowah has said; I well remember, on your part, the loving-kindness of your youth, the love during your being engaged to marry, your walking after me in the wilderness, in a land not sown with seed. (Jeremiah 2:2)
- That I may not strip her naked and actually place her as in the day of her being born, and actually set her like a wilderness and place her like a waterless land and put her to death with thirst. (Hosea 2:3)
- When Israel was a boy, then I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son. (Hosea 11:1)
- O how the faithful town has become a prostitute! She was full of justice, righteousness itself used to lodge in her, but now murderers. (Isaiah 1:21)
- And they began to prostitute themselves in Egypt. In their youth they committed prostitution. There their breasts were squeezed, and there they pressed the bosoms of their virginity. (Ezekiel 23:3)
- And she kept multiplying her acts of prostitution to the point of calling to mind the days of her youth, when she prostituted herself in the land of Egypt. (Ezekiel 23:19)
- And I will give her her vineyards from then onward, and the low plain of Achor as an entrance to hope, and she will certainly

answer there as in the days of her youth and as in the day of her coming up out of the land of Egypt. (Hosea 2:15)
