

Ezekiel 16:35 **Therefore, O prostitute, hear the word of Yehowah.**

[5] - References:

- The righteous one himself has perished, but there is no one taking it to heart. And men of loving-kindness are being gathered to the dead, while no one discerns that it is because of the calamity that the righteous one has been gathered away. (**Isaiah 57:1**)
- He enters into peace, they take rest upon their beds, each one that is walking straightforwardly. (**Isaiah 57:2**)
- As for **you** men, come up close here, **you** sons of a soothsaying woman, the seed of an adulterous person and of a woman that commits prostitution. (**Isaiah 57:3**)
- Over whom is it that **you** have a jolly good time? Against whom do **you** keep opening wide the mouth, keep sticking out the tongue? Are **you** not the children of transgression, the seed of falsehood. (**Isaiah 57:4**)
- Those who are working up passion among big trees, under every luxuriant tree, slaughtering the children in the torrent valleys under the clefts of the crags? (**Isaiah 57:5**)
- O how the faithful town has become a **prostitute**! She was full of justice, righteousness itself used to lodge in her, but now murderers. (**Isaiah 1:21**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to say to me in the days of Josiah the king; Have you seen what unfaithful Israel has done? She is going upon every high mountain and underneath every luxuriant tree, that she may commit prostitution there. (**Jeremiah 3:6**)
- For their mother has committed fornication. She that was pregnant with them has acted shamefully, for she has said, I want to go after those passionately loving me, those giving my bread and my water, my wool and my linen, my oil and my drink. (**Hosea 2:5**)
- Son of man, prophesy concerning the prophets of Israel who are prophesying, and you must say to those prophesying out of their own heart, Hear the **word** of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 13:2**)
