For the reason that you did not remember the days of your youth and you would cause me agitation because of all these things, even here I also, for my part, will put your own way upon your very head, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and you will certainly not carry on any loose conduct alongside all your detestable things.

- So it turned out that as she spoke to Joseph day after day he never listened to her to lie alongside her, to continue with her. (Genesis 39:10)
- But it happened that on this day as other days he went into the house to do his business, and there was none of the men of the house there in the house. (Genesis 39:11)

- If I have walked with men of untruth, and my foot hastens to deception. (Job 31:5)
- He will weigh me in accurate scales and God will get to know my integrity. (Job 31:6)

- If my stepping deviates from the way, or my heart has walked merely after my eyes, or any defect has stuck in my own palms. (Job 31:7)
- Let me sow seed and someone else eat, and let my own descendants be rooted out. (Job 31:8)
- If my heart has been enticed toward a woman, and I kept lying in wait at the very entranceway of my companion. (Job 31:9)
- Let my wife do the grinding for another man, and over her let other men kneel down. (Job 31:10)
- For that would be loose conduct, and that would be an error for attention by the justices. (Job 31:11)
- For that is a fire that would eat clear to destruction, and among all my produce it would take root. (Job 31:12)
- If I used to refuse the judgment of my slave man or of my slave girl in their case at Law with me. (Job 31:13)
- Then what can I do when God rises up? And when he calls for an accounting, what can I answer him? (Job 31:14)
- Do not take away my soul along with sinners, nor my life along with bloodguilty men. (Psalms 26:9)
- In whose hands there is loose conduct, and whose right hand is full of bribery. (Psalms 26:10)
- As for me, in my integrity I shall walk. O redeem me and show me favor. (Psalms 26:11)
- For in that day they will reject each one his worthless gods of silver and his valueless gods of gold, that YOUR hands have made for yourselves as a sin. (Isaiah 31:7)
- They did not remember his hand, the day that he redeemed them from the adversary. (Psalms 78:42)
- Can a virgin forget her ornaments, a bride her breastbands? And yet my own people, they have forgotten me days without number. (Jeremiah 2:32)
- For forty years I kept feeling a loathing toward that generation, and I proceeded to say; They are a people wayward at heart, and

- they themselves have not come to know my ways. (Psalms 95:10)
- And as for me also, my eye will not feel sorry, neither shall I show compassion. Their way I shall certainly bring upon their own head. (Ezekiel 9:10)
- But as for those whose heart is walking in their disgusting things and their detestable things, upon their head I shall certainly bring their own way, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 11:21)
- So I shall pour out my denunciation upon them. With the fire of my fury I will exterminate them. Their way I will bring upon their own head, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 22:31)
- And my eye will not feel sorry for you, neither will I feel compassion, for upon you I shall bring your own ways, and in the midst of you your own detestable things will come to be, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 7:4)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel compassion.

 According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and you people will have to know that I am Yehowah doing the smiting. (Ezekiel 7:9)
- And they must bring your loose conduct upon you, and the sins of your dungy idols you will bear, and you people will have to know that I am the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 23:49)
- I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. It must come, and I will act. I shall not neglect, neither shall I feel sorry nor feel regret.

 According to your ways and according to your dealings they will certainly judge you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 24:14)
