Ezekiel 16:53... And I will gather their captive ones, the captive ones of Sodom and of her dependent towns, and the captive ones of Samaria and of her dependent towns, I will also gather your captive ones in the midst of them.

- In that day Israel will come to be the third with Egypt and with Assyria, namely, a blessing in the midst of the earth. (Isaiah 19:24)
