Ezekiel 16:57... Before your own badness got to be exposed, just as at the time of the reproach of the daughters of Syria¹ and of all round about her, the daughters of the Philistines, those treating you with scorn on all sides.

- May those be ashamed, may those come to their end, who are resisting my soul. May those cover themselves with reproach and humiliation who are seeking calamity for me. (Psalms 71:13)
- But as for me, I shall wait constantly, and I will add to all your praise. (Psalms 71:14)
- My own mouth will recount your righteousness, all day long your salvation, for I have not come to know the numbers of them.
 (Psalms 71:15)
- Remember, O Yehowah, the reproach upon your servants, my carrying in my bosom the reproach of all the many peoples. (Psalms 89:50)
- How your enemies have reproached, O Yehowah, how they have reproached the footprints of your anointed one. (Psalms 89:51)
- Every one will certainly become ashamed of a people that bring no benefit to one, that are of no help and bring no benefit, but are a reason for shame and also a cause for reproach. (Isaiah 30:5)
- And I shall make you a devastated place and a reproach among the nations that are all around you before the eyes of every passerby. (Ezekiel 5:14)
- And you must become a reproach and an object of reviling words, a warning example and a horror to the nations that are all around you, when I do in you acts of judgment in anger and in rage and in raging reproofs. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. (Ezekiel 5:15)
- Your error, O daughter of Zion, has come to its finish. He will not carry you off into exile again. He has turned his attention to your

- error, O daughter of Edom. He has uncovered your sins. (Lamentations 4:22)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; By reason of Your causing Your error to be remembered by Your transgressions being uncovered, in order that Your sins may be seen according to all Your dealings, by reason of Your being called to remembrance You people will be seized even by the hand. (Ezekiel 21:24)
- And now I shall uncover her private parts to the eyes of her passionate lovers, and there will be no man to snatch her out of my hand. (Hosea 2:10)
- It was then that Rezin the king of Syria and Pekah the son of Remaliah the king of Israel proceeded to come up against Jerusalem in war and laid siege against Ahaz, but they were not able to fight. (2 Kings 16:5)
- Consequently Yehowah his God gave him into the hand of the king of Syria, so that they struck him and carried off from him a great number of captives and brought them to Damascus. And also into the hand of the king of Israel he was given, so that he struck him with a great slaughter. (2 Chronicles 28:5)
- Now it came about in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham the son of Uzziah, the king of Judah, that Rezin the king of Syria and Pekah the son of Remaliah, the king of Israel, came up to Jerusalem for war against it, and he proved unable to war against it. (Isaiah 7:1)
- As for the Philistines, they made a raid upon the cities of the Shephelah and the Negeb of Judah and got to capture Bethshemesh and Aijalon and Gederoth and Soco and its dependent towns and Timnah and its dependent towns and Gimzo and its dependent towns, and they took up dwelling there. (2 Chronicles 28:18)
- Have you not seen what those of this people have spoken, saying, The two families whom Yehowah has chosen, he will also reject them? And my own people they keep treating with disrespect, so that it should no more continue being a nation before them. (Jeremiah 33:24)
- And no more will there prove to be to the house of Israel a malignant prickle or a painful thorn out of all those round about

them, those who are treating them with scorn, and people will have to know that I am the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 28:24)
