Ezekiel 16:59... For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, I also must do with you just as you have done, because you despised the oath in breaking my covenant.1

- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Woe to the city of deeds of bloodshed, the widemouthed cooking pot, the rust of which is in it, and the very rust of which has not gone forth from it! Piece by piece of it, bring it out, no lot must be cast over it. (Ezekiel 24:6)
- For its very blood has come to be right in the midst of it. Upon the shining, bare surface of a crag she placed it. She did not pour it out upon the earth, in order to cover it over with dust. (Ezekiel 24:7)
- In order to bring up rage for the executing of vengeance, I have put her blood upon the shining, bare surface of a crag, in order that it may not be covered over. (Ezekiel 24:8)
- Now after these things it came about that the wife of his master began to raise her eyes toward Joseph and say; Lie down with me. (Genesis 39:7)
- But he would refuse and would say to his master's wife; Here my master does not know what is with me in the house, and everything he has he has given into my hand. (Genesis 39:8)
- There is no one greater in this house than I am, and he has not withheld from me anything at all except you, because you are his wife. So how could I commit this great badness and actually sin against God? (Genesis 39:9)
- So it turned out that as she spoke to Joseph day after day he never listened to her to lie alongside her, to continue with her. (Genesis 39:10)
- But it happened that on this day as other days he went into the house to do his business, and there was none of the men of the house there in the house. (Genesis 39:11)

- Then she grabbed hold of him by his garment, saying; Lie down with me! But he left his garment in her hand and took to flight and went on outside. (Genesis 39:12)
- Also loving-kindness belongs to you, O Yehowah, for you yourself pay back to each one according to his work. (Psalms 62:12)
- Woe to the wicked one, calamity! For the treatment rendered by his own hands will be rendered to him! (Isaiah 3:11)
- And he will render to each one according to his works. (Romans 2:6)
- Do not be misled! God is not one to be mocked. For whatever a man is sowing, this he will also reap. (Galatians 6:7)
- In order for you to enter into the covenant of Yehowah your God and his oath, which Yehowah your God is concluding with you today. (Deuteronomy 29:12)
- And they will have to say; On account of the fact that they left the covenant of Yehowah their God and proceeded to bow down to other gods and to serve them. (Jeremiah 22:9)
- They have returned to the errors of their forefathers, the first ones, who refused to obey my words, but who themselves have walked after other gods in order to serve them. The house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant that I concluded with their forefathers. (Jeremiah 11:10)
- Not one like the covenant that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, which covenant of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 31:32)
- But he finally rebelled against him in sending his messengers to Egypt, for it to give him horses and a multitudinous people. Will he have success? Will he escape, he who is doing these things, and who has broken a covenant? And will he actually escape? (Ezekiel 17:15)
- To your mouth, a horn! One comes like an eagle against the house of Yehowah, for the reason that they have overstepped my covenant, and against my Law they have transgressed. (Hosea 8:1)

So I took my staff Pleasantness and cut it to pieces, in order to break my covenant that I had concluded with all the peoples. (Zechariah 11:10)
