Icame passing along by you and got to see you, and, look! Your time was the time for love's expressions. So I proceeded to spread my skirt over you and to cover your nudeness and to make a sworn statement to you and enter into a covenant with you, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, and so you became mine.

- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will conclude with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah a New Covenant. (Jeremiah 31:31)
- Not one like the covenant that I concluded with their forefathers in the day of my taking hold of their hand to bring them forth out of the land of Egypt, which covenant of mine they themselves broke, although I myself had husbandly ownership of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 31:32)
- For this is the covenant that I shall conclude with the house of Israel after those days, is the utterance of Yehowah. I will put my Law within them, and in their heart I shall write it. And I will become their God, and they themselves will become my people. (Jeremiah 31:33)
- And they will no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; Know Yehowah! For they will all of them know me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin I shall remember no more. (Jeremiah 31:34)
- This is what Yehowah, the Giver of the sun for light by day, the statutes of the moon and the stars for light by night, the One stirring up the sea that its waves may become boisterous, the One whose name is Yehowah of armies, has said. (Jeremiah 31:35)
- This is my covenant that you men will keep, between me and you men, even your seed after you; Every male of yours must get circumcised. (Genesis 17:10)
- You are my witnesses, is the utterance of Yehowah, even my servant whom I have chosen, in order that you may know and have faith in me, and that you may understand that I am the

- same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none. (Isaiah 43:10)
- I, I am Yehowah, and besides me there is no savior. (Isaiah 43:11)
- I myself have told forth and have saved and have caused it to be heard, when there was among you no strange god. So you are my witnesses, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I am God. (Isaiah 43:12)
- Also, all the time I am the same One, and there is no one effecting deliverance out of my own hand. I shall get active, and who can turn it back? (Isaiah 43:13)
- Then he said; Who are you? In turn she said; I am Ruth your slave girl, and you must spread out your skirt over your slave girl, for you are a repurchaser. (Ruth 3:9)
- For Yehowah will not desert his people for the sake of his great name, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to make you his people. (1 Samuel 12:22)
- You, whom I have taken hold of from the extremities of the earth, and you, whom I have called even from the remote parts of it. And so I said to you, You are my servant, I have chosen you, and I have not rejected you. (Isaiah 41:9)
- And now if you will strictly obey my voice and will indeed keep my covenant, then you will certainly become my special property out of all other peoples, because the whole earth belongs to me. (Exodus 19:5)
- For Yehowah your God is a merciful God. He will not desert you or bring you to ruin or forget the covenant of your forefathers that he swore to them. (Deuteronomy 4:31)
- Go, and you must call out in the ears of Jerusalem, saying; This is what Yehowah has said; I well remember, on your part, the loving-kindness of your youth, the love during your being engaged to marry, your walking after me in the wilderness, in a land not sown with seed. (Jeremiah 2:2)
- As for Yehowah, he has induced you to say today that you will become his people, a special property, just as he has promised

you, and that you will observe all his commandments. (Deuteronomy 26:18)

- For Yehowah's share is his people, Jacob is the allotment that he inherits. (Deuteronomy 32:9)
- And Yehowah your God did not want to listen to Balaam, but Yehowah your God in your behalf changed the malediction into a blessing, because Yehowah your God loved you. (Deuteronomy 23:5)
- For your Grand Maker is your husbandly owner, Yehowah of armies being his name, and the Holy One of Israel is your Repurchaser. The God of the whole earth he will be called. (Isaiah 54:5)
- For the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah have proved to be mere doers of what was bad in my eyes, from their youth on up, for the sons of Israel are even offending me by the work of their hands, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 32:30)
- And she will actually chase after her passionate lovers, but she will not overtake them, and she will certainly look for them, but she will not find them. And she will have to say, I want to go and return to my husband, the first one, for I had it better at that time than now. (Hosea 2:7)
