- For I have not held back from telling **you** all the counsel of God. (**Acts of Apostles 20:27**)
- In reply his master said to him; Wicked and sluggish slave, you knew, did you, that I reaped where I did not sow and gathered where I did not winnow? (**Matthew 25:26**)
- I shall wash my hands in innocency itself, and I will march around your altar, O Yehowah. (**Psalms 26:6**)
- Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean, remove the badness of **YOUR** dealings from in front of my eyes, cease to do bad. (**Isaiah 1:16**)
- You arrange before me a table in front of those showing hostility to me. With **oil** you have **greased** my head, my cup is well filled. (**Psalms 23:5**)
- When Yehowah will have washed **away** the excrement of the daughters of Zion and he will rinse **away** even the bloodshed of Jerusalem from within her by the spirit of judgment and by the spirit of burning down. (**Isaiah 4:4**)
