look! He had given his hand and has done even all these things. He will not make his escape.

- But the loving-kindness of Yehowah is from time indefinite even to time indefinite toward those fearing him, and his righteousness to the sons of sons. (Psalms 103:17)
- Toward those keeping his covenant and toward those remembering his orders so as to carry them out. (Psalms 103:18)
- And they will have to say; On account of the fact that they left the covenant of Yehowah their God and proceeded to bow down to other gods and to serve them. (Jeremiah 22:9)
- Just let Your word Yes mean Yes, Your No, No, for what is in excess of these is from the wicked one. (Matthew 5:37)
- Without understanding, false to agreements, having no natural affection, merciless. (Romans 1:31)
- To Egypt we have given the hand, to Assyria, in order to get satisfaction with bread. (Lamentations 5:6)
- But he finally rebelled against him in sending his messengers to Egypt, for it to give him horses and a multitudinous people. Will he have success? Will he escape, he who is doing these things, and who has broken a covenant? And will he actually escape? (Ezekiel 17:15)
- Shout a war cry against her on every side. She has given her hand. Her pillars have fallen. Her walls have been torn down. For it is the vengeance of Yehowah. Take YOUR vengeance on her. Just as she has done, do to her. (Jeremiah 50:15)
