- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** raise up to David a righteous sprout. And a king **will certainly** reign and act with discretion and execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 23:5**)
- In his days Judah **will** be saved, and **Israel** itself **will reside** in security. And this is his name with which he **will** be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (**Jeremiah 23:6**)
- Hear, please, O Joshua the High Priest, you and your companions who are sitting before you, for they are men serving as portents, for here I am bringing in my servant Sprout! (**Zechariah 3:8**)
- In that day what Yehowah makes sprout **will** come to be for decoration and for glory, and the fruitage of the land **will** be something to be proud of and something beautiful for those of **Israel** who have escaped. (**Isaiah 4:2**)
- In those days and at that time I shall make sprout for David a righteous sprout, and he **will certainly** execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 33:15**)
- Those who are planted in the house of Yehowah, in the courtyards of our God, they **will** blossom forth. (**Psalms 92:13**)
- By the decree of watchers the thing is, and by the saying of holy ones the request is, to the intent that people living may know that the Most High is Ruler in the kingdom of mankind and that to the one whom he wants to, he gives it and he sets up over it even the lowliest one of mankind. (**Daniel 4:17**)
- In the coming days Jacob **will** take root, **Israel will** put forth blossoms and **actually** sprout, and they **will** simply fill the surface of the productive land with **produce**. (**Isaiah 27:6**)
- The righteous himself **will** blossom forth as a palm tree does, as a **cedar** in Lebanon does, he **will** grow big. (**Psalms 92:12**)

- And he **will** have subjects from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (**Psalms 72:8**)
- They **will** again be dwellers in his **shadow**. They **will** grow grain, and **will** bud like the vine. His memorial **will** be like the wine of Lebanon. (**Hosea 14:7**)
- The trees of Yehowah are satisfied, the **cedars** of Lebanon that he planted. (**Psalms 104:16**)
- For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the **height** of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, there is where they, the whole house of **Israel** in its entirety, **will** serve me, in the land. There I shall take pleasure in them, and there I shall require **YOUR** contributions and the firstfruits of **YOUR** presentations in all **YOUR** holy things. (**Ezekiel 20:40**)
- On its **boughs** all the flying creatures of the heavens made their nests, and **under** its branches all the wild beasts of the field gave birth, and in its shade all the populous nations would dwell. (**Ezekiel 31:6**)
- Which is, in fact, the tiniest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the largest of the vegetables and **becomes** a tree, so that the **birds** of heaven come and find lodging among its branches. (**Matthew 13:32**)
- It is like a mustard grain that a man took and put in his garden, and it grew and became a tree, and the **birds** of heaven took up lodging in its branches. (**Luke 13:19**)
