Ezekiel 17:23... On the mountain of the height of Israel I shall transplant it, and it will certainly bear boughs and produce fruit and become a majestic cedar. And under it there will actually reside all the birds of every wing, in the shadow of its foliage they will reside.

- Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will raise up to David a righteous sprout. And a king will certainly reign and act with discretion and execute justice and righteousness in the land. (Jeremiah 23:5)
- In his days Judah will be saved, and Israel itself will reside in security. And this is his name with which he will be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (Jeremiah 23:6)
- Hear, please, O Joshua the High Priest, you and your companions who are sitting before you, for they are men serving as portents, for here I am bringing in my servant Sprout! (Zechariah 3:8)
- In that day what Yehowah makes sprout will come to be for decoration and for glory, and the fruitage of the land will be something to be proud of and something beautiful for those of Israel who have escaped. (Isaiah 4:2)
- In those days and at that time I shall make sprout for David a righteous sprout, and he will certainly execute justice and righteousness in the land. (Jeremiah 33:15)
- Those who are planted in the house of Yehowah, in the courtyards of our God, they will blossom forth. (Psalms 92:13)
- By the decree of watchers the thing is, and by the saying of holy ones the request is, to the intent that people living may know that the Most High is Ruler in the kingdom of mankind and that to the one whom he wants to, he gives it and he sets up over it even the lowliest one of mankind. (Daniel 4:17)
- In the coming days Jacob will take root, Israel will put forth blossoms and actually sprout, and they will simply fill the surface of the productive land with produce. (Isaiah 27:6)
- The righteous himself will blossom forth as a palm tree does, as a cedar in Lebanon does, he will grow big. (Psalms 92:12)

- And he will have subjects from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (Psalms 72:8)
- They will again be dwellers in his shadow. They will grow grain, and will bud like the vine. His memorial will be like the wine of Lebanon. (Hosea 14:7)
- The trees of Yehowah are satisfied, the cedars of Lebanon that he planted. (Psalms 104:16)
- For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, there is where they, the whole house of Israel in its entirety, will serve me, in the land. There I shall take pleasure in them, and there I shall require YOUR contributions and the firstfruits of YOUR presentations in all YOUR holy things. (Ezekiel 20:40)
