Ezekiel 17:9" Say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Will it have success? Will not someone tear out its very roots and make its very fruit scaly? And must not all its freshly plucked sprouts become dry? It will become dry. Neither by a great arm nor by a multitudinous people will it have to be lifted up from its roots.

- And now, O you inhabitants of Jerusalem and you men of Judah, please judge between me and my vineyard. (Isaiah 5:3)
- What is there yet to do for my vineyard that I have not already done in it? Why is it that I hoped for it to produce grapes, but it gradually produced wild grapes? (Isaiah 5:4)
- And now, please, may I make known to you men what I am doing to my vineyard; There will be a removing of its hedge, and it must be destined for burning down. There must be a breaking down of its stone wall, and it must be destined for a place of trampling. (Isaiah 5:5)
- And I shall set it as a thing destroyed. It will not be pruned, nor will it be hoed. And it must come up with the thornbush and weeds, and upon the clouds I shall lay a command to keep from precipitating any rain upon it. (Isaiah 5:6)
- For the vineyard of Yehowah of armies is the house of Israel, and the men of Judah are the plantation of which he was fond. And he kept hoping for judgment, but, look! The breaking of Law, for righteousness, but, look! An outcry. (Isaiah 5:7)
- And as for me, I had planted you as a choice red vine, all of it a true seed. So how have you been changed toward me into the degenerate shoots of a foreign vine? (Jeremiah 2:21)
- But Moses said; Why is it that you are passing beyond the order of Yehowah? But that will not succeed. (Numbers 14:41)
- And, look! With us there is at the head the true God with his priests and the signal trumpets for sounding the battle alarm against You. O sons of Israel, do not fight against Yehowah the God of YOUR forefathers, for YOU will not prove successful. (2 Chronicles 13:12)

- And to Babylon he will take Zedekiah, and there he will continue until I turn my attention to him, is the utterance of Yehowah, although you men keep warring against the Chaldeans, you will not succeed? (Jeremiah 32:5)
- And after that, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall give Zedekiah the king of Judah and his servants and the people and those who are remaining over in this city from the pestilence, from the sword and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, even into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those who are seeking for their soul, and he will certainly strike them with the edge of the sword. He will not feel sorry for them, nor will he show compassion or have any mercy. (Jeremiah 21:7)
- And Zedekiah's sons they slaughtered before his eyes, and Zedekiah's eyes he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters and brought him to Babylon. (2 Kings 25:7)
- And the king of Babylon proceeded to slaughter the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes, and also all the princes of Judah he slaughtered in Riblah. (Jeremiah 52:10)
- For you will become like a big tree the foliage of which is withering, and like a garden that has no water. (Isaiah 1:30)
