Ezekiel 18:18... As for his father, because he committed outright defrauding, wrested something away in robbery of a brother, and whatever is not good he has done in the midst of his peoples, look! Then he must die for his error.

- You must not defraud your fellow, and you must not rob. The wages of a hired laborer should not stay all night with you until morning. (Leviticus 19:13)
- Yehowah and does deceive his associate about something in his charge or a deposit in hand or a robbery or he does defraud his associate. (Leviticus 6:2)
- Woe to the wicked one! Calamity! For the treatment rendered by his own hands will be rendered to him! (Isaiah 3:11)
- When I say to someone wicked; You will positively die, and you do not actually warn him and speak in order to warn the wicked one from his wicked way to preserve him alive, he being wicked, in his error he will die, but his blood I shall ask back from your own hand. (Ezekiel 3:18)
- The very despoiling by the wicked ones will drag them away, for they have refused to do justice. (Proverbs 21:7)
