Ezekiel 18:25... And you people will certainly say; The way of Yehowah¹ is not adjusted right. Hear, please, O house of Israel. Is not my own way adjusted right? Are not the ways of you people not adjusted right?

- You hypocrites, Isaiah aptly prophesied about You, when he said. (Matthew 15:7)
- This people honors me with their lips, yet their heart is far removed from me. (Matthew 15:8)
- It is in vain that they keep worshiping me, because they teach commands of men as doctrines. (Matthew 15:9)
- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24:14)
- For everyone doing these things, every doer of injustice, is something detestable to Yehowah your God. (Deuteronomy 25:16)
- And as for everyone that does not become a doer of the Law of your God and the Law of the king, let judgment be promptly executed upon him, whether for death or for banishment, or for money fine or for imprisonment. (Ezra 7:26)
- Jesus answered them; Most truly I say to YOU, every doer of sin is a slave of sin. (John 8:34)
- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (James 1:22)
- For if anyone is a hearer of the word, and not a doer, this one is like a man looking at his natural face in a mirror. (James 1:23)
- For he looks at himself, and off he goes and immediately forgets what sort of man he is. (James 1:24)
- But he who peers into the perfect Law that belongs to freedom and who persists in it, this man, because he has become, not a

- forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, will be happy in his doing it. (James 1:2)
- But you, do not you be called Rabbi, for one is your teacher, whereas all you are brothers. (Matthew 23:8)
- Do you not know that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple you people are. (1 Corinthians 3:17)
- Jesus answered them; I chose you twelve, did I not? Yet one of you is a slanderer. (John 6:70)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among you. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (2 Peter 2:1)
- He is set in opposition and lifts himself up over everyone who is called god or an object of reverence, so that he sits down in the temple of The God, publicly showing himself to be a god. (2 Thessalonians 2:4)
- Do you not remember that, while I was yet with you, I used to tell you these things? (2 Thessalonians 2:5)
- For Job has said, I certainly am in the right, but God himself has turned aside the judgment of me. (Job 34:5)
- Is this what you have regarded as justice? You have said; My righteousness is more than God's. (Job 35:2)
- It is the foolishness of an earthling man that distorts his way, and so his heart becomes enraged against Yehowah himself. (Proverbs 19:3)
- And the sons of your people have said; The way of Yehowah is not adjusted right, but, as for them, it is their way that is not adjusted right. (Ezekiel 33:17)
- You people have made Yehowah weary by Your words, and You have said, In what way have we made him weary? By Your

- saying; Everyone that is doing bad is good in the eyes of Yehowah, and in such ones he himself has taken delight. Or; Where is the God of justice? (Malachi 2:17)
- O man, who, then, really are you to be answering back to God? Shall the thing molded say to him that molded it; Why did you make me this way? (Romans 9:20)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)
- Yehowah is righteous in all his ways and loyal in all his works. (Psalms 145:17)
- These things you have done, and I kept silent. You imagined that I would positively become like you. I am going to reprove you, and I will set things in order before your eyes. (Psalms 50:21)
- For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my ways are higher than YOUR ways, and my thoughts than YOUR thoughts. (Isaiah 55:9)
- Is not this what you proceeded to do to yourself by your leaving Yehowah your God during the time of his walking you in the way? (Jeremiah 2:17)
