[23] - References:

- **You** hypocrites, Isaiah aptly prophesied about **you**, when he said. (**Matthew 15:7**)
- This **people** honors me with their lips, yet their heart is far removed from me. (**Matthew 15:8**)
- It is in vain that they keep worshiping me, because they teach commands of men as doctrines. (**Matthew 15:9**)
- And this Good News of the kingdom **will** be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end **will** come. (**Matthew 24:14**)
- For everyone doing these things, every doer of injustice, is something detestable to Yehowah your God. (**Deuteronomy 25:16**)
- And as for everyone that does not become a doer of the Law of your God and the Law of the king, let judgment be promptly executed upon him, whether for death or for banishment, or for money fine or for imprisonment. (**Ezra 7:26**)
- Jesus answered them; Most truly I **say** to **you**, every doer of sin is a slave of sin. (**John 8:34**)
- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (**James 1:22**)
- For if anyone is a hearer of the word, and not a doer, this one is like a man looking at his natural face in a mirror. (**James 1:23**)
- For he looks at himself, and off he goes and immediately forgets what sort of man he is. (**James 1:24**)
- But he who peers into the perfect Law that belongs to freedom and who persists in it, this man, because he has become, not a

- forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, **will** be happy in his doing it. (**James 1:2**)
- But **you**, do not **you** be called Rabbi, for one is **your** teacher, whereas all **you** are brothers. (**Matthew 23:8**)
 - Do **you** not know that **you people** are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in **you**? (**1 Corinthians 3:16**)
 - If anyone destroys the temple of God, God **will** destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple **you people** are. (**1 Corinthians 3:17**)
 - Jesus answered them; I chose **you** twelve, did I not? Yet one of **you** is a slanderer. (**John 6:70**)
 - However, there also came to be false prophets among the **people**, as there **will** also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones **will** quietly bring in destructive sects and **will** disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
 - He is set in opposition and lifts himself up over everyone who is called god or an object of reverence, so that he sits down in the temple of The God, publicly showing himself to be a god. (**2 Thessalonians 2:4**)
 - Do **you** not remember that, while I was yet with **you**, I used to tell **you** these things? (**2 Thessalonians 2:5**)
 - For Job has said, I **certainly** am in the **right**, but God himself has turned aside the judgment of me. (**Job 34:5**)
 - Is this what you have regarded as justice? You have said; My righteousness is more than God's. (**Job 35:2**)
 - It is the foolishness of an earthling man that distorts his **way**, and so his heart becomes enraged against Yehowah himself. (**Proverbs 19:3**)
 - And the sons of your **people** have said; The **way** of Yehowah is not **adjusted** right, but, as for them, it is their **way** that is not **adjusted right**. (**Ezekiel 33:17**)
 - **You people** have made Yehowah weary by **your** words, and **you** have said, In what **way** have we made him weary? By **your**

- saying; Everyone that is doing bad is good in the eyes of Yehowah, and in such ones he himself has taken delight. Or; Where is the God of justice? (**Malachi 2:17**)
- O man, who, then, really are you to be answering back to God? Shall the thing molded **say** to him that molded it; Why did you make me this way? (**Romans 9:20**)
 - The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his **ways** are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
 - Yehowah is righteous in all his **ways** and loyal in all his works. (**Psalms 145:17**)
 - These things you have done, and I kept silent. You imagined that I would positively become like you. I am going to reprove you, and I **will** set things in order before your eyes. (**Psalms 50:21**)
 - For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so my **ways** are higher than **YOUR ways**, and my thoughts than **YOUR** thoughts. (**Isaiah 55:9**)
 - Is not this what you proceeded to do to yourself by your leaving Yehowah your God during the time of his walking you in the **way**? (**Jeremiah 2:17**)
 - This is what you **will say** to the prophet; What answer has Yehowah given you? And what has Yehowah spoken? (**Jeremiah 23:37**)
