

**Ezekiel 18:27** And when someone wicked turns back from his wickedness that he has committed and proceeds to execute justice and righteousness, he is the one that will preserve his own soul alive.

- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (**James 1:22**)
- For if anyone is a hearer of the word, and not a doer, this one is like a man looking at his natural face in a mirror. (**James 1:23**)
- For he looks at himself, and off he goes and immediately forgets what sort of man he is. (**James 1:24**)
- But he who peers into the perfect Law that belongs to freedom and who persists in it, this man, because he **has** become, not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, **will** be happy in his doing it. (**James 1:2**)
- This is my comfort in my affliction, for your **own** saying **has** preserved me **alive**. (**Psalms 119:50**)
- To time indefinite I shall not forget your orders, because by them you have preserved me **alive**. (**Psalms 119:93**)
- Come, now, **you** people, and let us set matters straight between us, says Yehowah. Though the sins of **you** people should prove to be as scarlet, they **will** be made white just like snow, though they should be red like crimson cloth, they **will** become even like wool. (**Isaiah 1:18**)
- Let the **wicked** man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to Yehowah, who **will** have mercy upon him, and to our God, for he **will** forgive in a large way. (**Isaiah 55:7**)
- But both to those in Damascus first and to those in Jerusalem, and over all the country of Judea, and to the nations I went bringing the message that they should repent and turn to God by doing works that befit repentance. (**Acts of Apostles 26:20**)
- Pay constant attention to yourself and to your teaching. Stay by these things, for by doing this you **will** save both yourself and those who listen to you. (**1 Timothy 4:16**)

- If you turn to doing good, **will** there not be an exaltation? But if you do not turn to doing good, there is sin crouching at the entrance, and for you is its craving, and **will** you, for your part, get the mastery over it? (**Genesis 4:7**)
- The Law of Yehowah is perfect, bringing **back** the **soul**. The reminder of Yehowah is trustworthy, making the inexperienced one wise. (**Psalms 19:7**)
- But to the **wicked** one God **will** have to say; What right do you have to enumerate my regulations, and that you may bear my covenant in your mouth? (**Psalms 50:16**)
- Perhaps they **will** listen and return, each one from his bad way, and I shall have to feel regret for the calamity that I am thinking to **execute** upon them because of the badness of their dealings. (**Jeremiah 26:3**)
- And when someone **wicked turns back** from his **wickedness** and actually carries on **justice** and **righteousness**, it **will** be on account of them that he himself **will** keep living. (**Ezekiel 33:19**)
