judge You, O house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. Turn back, yes, cause a turning back from all Your transgressions, and let nothing prove to be for You people a stumbling block causing error.

- And he will uncover their ear to exhortation, and he will say that they should turn back from what is hurtful. (Job 36:10)
- Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean, remove the badness of your dealings from in front of my eyes, cease to do bad. (Isaiah 1:16)
