Ezekiel 18:9" In my statutes he kept walking and my judicial decisions he kept in order to execute truth, he is righteous. He will positively keep living, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah.

- Watch out for yourself that you may not forget Yehowah your God so as not to keep his commandments and his judicial decisions and his statutes that I am commanding you today. (Deuteronomy 8:11)
- And now, O Israel, listen to the regulations and the judicial decisions that I am teaching you to do, in order that you may live and may indeed go in and take possession of the land that Yehowah the God of YOUR forefathers is giving YOU. (Deuteronomy 4:1)
- And Moses proceeded to call all Israel and to say to them; Hear, O Israel, the regulations and the judicial decisions that I am speaking in YOUR ears today, and YOU must learn them and be careful to do them. (Deuteronomy 5:1)
- And I proceeded to give them my statutes, and my judicial decisions I made known to them, in order that the man who keeps doing them might also keep living by them. (Ezekiel 20:11)
- He will carry away blessing from Yehowah and righteousness from his God of salvation. (Psalms 24:5)
- And you must keep my statutes and my judicial decisions, which if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 18:5)
- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your law, they themselves even acted presumptuously and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own judicial decisions they sinned, which, if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. And they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their neck they hardened, and they did not listen. (Nehemiah 9:29)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Israel, Search for me, and keep living. (Amos 5:4)

- For Moses writes that the man that has done the righteousness of the Law will live by it. (Romans 10:5)
- Now the Law does not adhere to faith, but, he that does them shall live by means of them. (Galatians 3:12)
- From the afflicted one he has drawn back his hand, no usury and interest has he taken, my judicial decisions he has carried out, in my statutes he has walked, he himself will not die because of the error of his father. He will positively keep living. (Ezekiel 18:17)
- And you people will certainly say; Why is it that the son does not have to bear anything because of the error of the father? Now as regards the son, justice and righteousness he has executed, all the statutes of mine he has kept and he keeps doing them. He will positively keep living. (Ezekiel 18:19)
- For I do not take any delight in the death of someone dying, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. So cause a turning back and keep living, O you people. (Ezekiel 18:32)
- But they, the house of Israel, rebelled against me in the wilderness. In my statutes they did not walk, and my judicial decisions they rejected, which, should the man keep doing, he will also keep living by them. And my Sabbaths they profaned very much, so that I promised to pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, in order to exterminate them. (Ezekiel 20:13)
