And as for the likeness of the living creatures,¹ their appearance was like burning coals of fire. Something like the appearance of torches was moving back and forth between the living creatures, and the fire was bright, and out of the fire there was lightning going forth.

Footnote: The living creatures Hebrew, *ha·chai·yohth'*, Feminine plural; Greek, *zoi'on*, the same word as in (Revelation 4:6-9) Latin, *a·ni·ma'li·um*

[5] - References:

- Making his angels spirits, this ministers a devouring fire. (**Psalms 104:4**)
- There was a stream of fire flowing and going out from before him. There were a thousand thousands that kept ministering to him, and ten thousand times ten thousand that kept standing right before him. The Court took its seat, and there were books that were opened. (**Daniel 7:10**)
- Before him a very fire goes, and it consumes his adversaries all around. (**Psalms 97:3**)
- Then the cherub thrust his hand out from between the cherubs to the fire that was between the cherubs and carried and put it into the hollows of the hands of the one clothed with the linen, who now took it and went out. (**Ezekiel 10:7**)
- And out of the throne there are proceeding lightnings and voices and thunders, and there are seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, and these mean the seven spirits of God. (**Revelation 4:5**)
