[4] - References:

- Every creature that splits the hoof and forms a cleft in the hoofs and chews the cud among the beasts, that is what **you** may eat. (**Leviticus 11:3**)
- And his body was like chrysolite, and his face like the appearance of lightning, and his eyes like fiery torches, and his arms and the place of his **feet** were like the sight of **burnished copper**, and the sound of his words was like the sound of a crowd. (**Daniel 10:6**)
- And his **feet** were like fine **copper** when glowing in a furnace, and his voice was as the sound of many waters. (**Revelation 1:15**)
- And he proceeded to bring me there, and, look! There was a man. His appearance was like the appearance of **copper**, and there was a flax cord in his hand, and a measuring reed, and he was standing in the gate. (**Ezekiel 40:3**)
