decisions I made known to them, in order that the man¹ who keeps doing them might also keep living by them.

- And you must keep my statutes and my judicial decisions, which if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 18:5)
- This is he that came to be among the congregation in the wilderness with the angel that spoke to him on Mount Sinai and with our forefathers, and he received living sacred pronouncements to give you. (Acts of Apostles 7:38)
- It is a statute to time indefinite for YOUR generations, in all YOUR dwelling places; You must not eat any fat or any blood at all. (Leviticus 3:17)
- And what great nation is there that has righteous regulations and judicial decisions like all this Law that I am putting before YOU today? (Deuteronomy 4:8)
- And upon Mount Sinai you came down and spoke with them out of heaven and went on to give them upright judicial decisions and laws of truth, good regulations and commandments. (Nehemiah 9:13)
- He is telling his word to Jacob, this regulations and his judicial decisions to Israel. (Psalms 147:19)
- So he humbled you and let you go hungry and fed you with the manna, which neither you had known nor your fathers had known, in order to make you know that not by bread alone does man live but by every expression of Yehowah's mouth does man live. (Deuteronomy 8:3)
- If you will listen to the commandments of Yehowah your God, which I am commanding you today, so as to love Yehowah your God, to walk in his ways and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judicial decisions, then you will be bound to keep alive and to multiply, and Yehowah your God must bless

- you in the land to which you are going to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 30:16)
- He said to him; You answered correctly, keep on doing this and you will get life. (Luke 10:28)
- For Moses writes that the man that has done the righteousness of the Law will live by it. (Romans 10:5)
- Now the Law does not adhere to faith, but he that does them shall live by means of them. (Galatians 3:12)
- And now, O Israel, listen to the regulations and the judicial decisions that I am teaching you to do, in order that you may live and may indeed go in and take possession of the land that Yehowah the God of your forefathers is giving you. (Deuteronomy 4:1)
- These are the testimonies and the regulations and the judicial decisions that Moses spoke to the sons of Israel on their coming out of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 4:45)
- And you stand here with me, and let me speak to you all the commandment and the regulations and the judicial decisions that you should teach to them and that they must do in the land that I am giving them to take possession of it. (Deuteronomy 5:31)
- You should by all means keep the commandments of Yehowah YOUR God and his testimonies and his regulations that he has commanded you. (Deuteronomy 6:17)
