Ezekiel 20:13... But they, the house of Israel, rebelled against me in the wilderness. In my statutes they did not walk, and my judicial decisions they rejected, which, should the man keep doing, he will also keep living by them. And my Sabbaths they profaned very much, so that I promised to pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, in order to exterminate them.

- And the people fell to quarreling with Moses and saying; Give us water that we may drink. But Moses said to them; Why are You quarreling with me? Why do You keep putting Yehowah to the test? (Exodus 17:2)
- They even went to saying to one another; Let us appoint a head, and let us return to Egypt! (Numbers 14:4)
- At this Moses and Aaron fell upon their faces before all the congregation of the assembly of the sons of Israel. (Numbers 14:5)
- And Joshua the son of Nun and Caleb the son of Jephunneh, who were of those who spied out the land, ripped their garments apart. (Numbers 14:6)
- And they proceeded to say this to all the assembly of the sons of Israel; The land that we passed through to spy it out is a very, very good land. (Numbers 14:7)
- If Yehowah has found delight in us, then he will certainly bring us into this land and give it to us, a land that is flowing with milk and honey. (Numbers 14:8)
- Only against Yehowah do not rebel, and You, do not You fear the people of the land, for they are bread to us. Their shelter has turned away from over them, and Yehowah is with us. Do not fear them. (Numbers 14:9)
- However, all the assembly talked of pelting them with stones. And Yehowah's glory appeared on the tent of meeting to all the sons of Israel. (Numbers 14:10)

- For I was scared because of the hot anger with which Yehowah had got indignant at you to the point of annihilating you. However, Yehowah listened to me also that time. (Deuteronomy 9:19)
- At Aaron, too, Yehowah got very incensed to the point of annihilating him, but I made supplication also in behalf of Aaron at that particular time. (Deuteronomy 9:20)
- So I kept prostrating myself before Yehowah forty days and forty nights, for I prostrated myself thus because Yehowah talked of annihilating YOU. (Deuteronomy 9:25)
- Of how much more severe a punishment, do you think, will the man be counted worthy who has trampled upon the Son of God and who has esteemed as of ordinary value the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and who has outraged the spirit of undeserved kindness with contempt? (Hebrews 10:29)
- They have turned aside in a hurry from the way I have commanded them to go. They have made a molten statue of a calf for themselves and keep bowing down to it and sacrificing to it and saying, This is your God, O Israel, who led you up out of the land of Egypt. (Exodus 32:8)
- But all the men who have been seeing my glory and my signs that I have performed in Egypt and in the wilderness and yet kept testing me these ten times, and have not listened to my voice. (Numbers 14:22)
- How often they would rebel against him in the wilderness, they would make him feel hurt in the desert! (Psalms 78:40)
- Do not harden YOUR heart as at Meribah, as in the day of Massah in the wilderness. (Psalms 95:8)
- And if you will reject my statutes, and if your souls will abhor my judicial decisions so as not to do all my commandments, to the extent of your violating my covenant. (Leviticus 26:15)
- All the while the land was left abandoned by them and was paying off its Sabbaths while it was lying desolated without them and they themselves were paying for their error, because, even because, they had rejected my judicial decisions, and their souls had abhorred my statutes. (Leviticus 26:43)

- And you keep neglecting all my counsel, and my reproof you have not accepted. (Proverbs 1:25)
- That you went building for yourself a mound and making for yourself a height in every public square. (Ezekiel 16:24)
- In my statutes he kept walking and my judicial decisions he kept in order to execute truth, he is righteous. He will positively keep living, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 18:9)
- For Moses writes that the man that has done the righteousness of the Law will live by it. (Romans 10:5)
- And the foreigners that have joined themselves to Yehowah to minister to him and to love the name of Yehowah, in order to become servants to him, all those keeping the Sabbath in order not to profane it and laying hold of my covenant. (Isaiah 56:6)
- Let me strike them with pestilence and drive them away, and let me make you a nation greater and mightier than they are.

 (Numbers 14:12)
- And you must keep the Sabbath, for it is something holy to you. A profaner of it will positively be put to death. In case there is anyone doing work on it, then that soul must be cut off from the midst of his people. (Exodus 31:14)
- And he was about to say to annihilate them, if it had not been for Moses his chosen one, who stood in the gap before him, to turn back his rage from bringing them to ruin. (Psalms 106:23)
- And the very land has been polluted under its inhabitants, for they have bypassed the laws, changed the regulation, broken the indefinitely lasting covenant. (Isaiah 24:5)
- But they did not listen or incline their ear, and they proceeded to harden their neck in order not to hear and in order to receive no discipline. (Jeremiah 17:23)
- And down to this day they did not feel crushed, and they did not become afraid, nor did they walk in my Law and in my statutes that I put before YOU and before YOUR forefathers. (Jeremiah 44:10)

- For the reason that they did not carry out my own judicial decisions and they rejected my own statutes and they profaned my own Sabbaths, and it was after the dungy idols of their forefathers that their eyes proved to be. (Ezekiel 20:24)
- My holy places you have despised, and my Sabbaths you have profaned. (Ezekiel 22:8)
- Her priests themselves have done violence to my Law, and they keep profaning my holy places. Between the holy thing and the common they have made no distinction, and between the unclean thing and the clean they have made nothing known, and from my Sabbaths they have hidden their eyes, and I am profaned in the midst of them. (Ezekiel 22:26)
- Consequently I say to YOU, it will be more endurable for Tyre and Sidon on Judgment Day than for YOU. (Matthew 11:22)
