Ezekiel 20:16... For the reason that they rejected my own judicial decisions, and as regards my statutes, they did not walk in them, and my Sabbaths they profaned, because it was after their dungy idols that their heart was going.

- Do you not know that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple you people are. (1 Corinthians 3:17)
- Outright slanderers have proved to be in you, for the purpose of shedding blood, and on the mountains they have eaten in you. Loose conduct they have carried on in the midst of you. (Ezekiel 22:9)
- Accordingly, put away all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies and all sorts of backbiting. (1 Peter 2:1)
- Then he took the gold from their hands, and he formed it with a graving tool and proceeded to make it into a molten statue of a calf. And they began to say; This is your God, O Israel, who led you up out of the land of Egypt. (Exodus 32:4)
- And it must serve as a fringed edge for You, and You must see it and remember all the commandments of Yehowah and do them, and You must not go about following Your hearts and Your eyes, which You are following in immoral intercourse. (Numbers 15:39)
- And the women came calling the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people began to eat and to bow down to their gods. (Numbers 25:2)
- And he went acting very detestably by going after the dungy idols, the same as all that the Amorites had done, whom Yehowah drove out from before the sons of Israel. (1 Kings 21:26)
- Therefore speak with them and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Any man at all of the house of Israel that brings up his dungy idols upon his heart and that places the very stumbling block causing his error in

front of his face and that actually comes to the prophet, I, Yehowah, I will let myself be brought to answer him in the matter according to the multitude of his dungy idols. (Ezekiel 14:4)

- So God turned and handed them over to render sacred service to the army of heaven, just as it is written in the book of the prophets; It was not to me that YOU offered victims and sacrifices for forty years in the wilderness, was it, O house of Israel? (Acts of Apostles 7:42)
- And you will have to know that I am Yehowah, because in my regulations you did not walk and my judgments you did not do, but according to the judgments of the nations that are round about you, you have done. (Ezekiel 11:12)
- And Oholah began to prostitute herself, while subject to me, and kept lusting after those passionately loving her, after the Assyrians, who were near. (Ezekiel 23:5)
