Ezekiel 20:18... And I proceeded to say to their sons in the wilderness, In the regulations of your forefathers do not you walk, and their judgments do not you keep, and with their dungy idols do not you defile yourselves.

- And I went on to say to them; Throw away, each one of You, the disgusting things of his eyes, and with the dungy idols of Egypt do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah Your God. (Ezekiel 20:7)
- And YOUR sons will become shepherds in the wilderness forty years, and they will have to answer for YOUR acts of fornication, until YOUR carcasses come to their end in the wilderness.

  (Numbers 14:33)
- And they should not become like their forefathers, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (Psalms 78:8)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, For the reason that you people were more turbulent than the nations that are all around you, in my statutes you did not walk and my judicial decisions you did not perform, but according to the judicial decisions of the nations that are all around you, you performed, did you not? (Ezekiel 5:7)
- Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears, you are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as your forefathers did, so you do. (Acts of Apostles 7:51)
- For you know that it was not with corruptible things, with silver or gold, that you were delivered from your fruitless form of conduct received by tradition from your forefathers. (1 Peter 1:18)
- And I gradually brought You to a land of the orchard, to eat its fruitage and its good things. But You came in and defiled my land, and my own inheritance You made something detestable. (Jeremiah 2:7)
- Accordingly he had the male temple prostitutes pass out of the land and removed all the dungy idols that his forefathers had made. (1 Kings 15:12)

- And do not become like YOUR forefathers and like YOUR brothers that acted unfaithfully toward Yehowah the God of their forefathers, so that he constituted them an object of astonishment, just as YOU are seeing. (2 Chronicles 30:7)
- And he proceeded to do what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, just as Manasseh his father had done, and to all the graven images that Manasseh his father had made Amon sacrificed, and he continued serving them. (2 Chronicles 33:22)
- And they got to be unclean by their works and kept having immoral intercourse by their dealings. (Psalms 106:39)
- They have returned to the errors of their forefathers, the first ones, who refused to obey my words, but who themselves have walked after other gods in order to serve them. The house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant that I concluded with their forefathers. (Jeremiah 11:10)
- And he went on to say to me; Son of man, I am sending you to the sons of Israel, to rebellious nations that have rebelled against me. They themselves and their forefathers have transgressed against me down to this selfsame day. (Ezekiel 2:3)
- And you people will certainly say; Why is it that the son does not have to bear anything because of the error of the father? Now as regards the son, justice and righteousness he has executed, all the statutes of mine he has kept and he keeps doing them. He will positively keep living. (Ezekiel 18:19)
