Ezekiel 20:21... And the sons began to rebel against me. In my statutes they did not walk, and my judicial decisions they did not keep by doing them, which, should the man¹ keep doing, he will also keep living by them. My Sabbaths they profaned. So I promised² to pour out my rage upon them, in order to bring my anger to its finish upon them in the wilderness.

- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (James 1:22)
- But the one that did not understand and so did things deserving of strokes will be beaten with few. Indeed, everyone to whom much was given, much will be demanded of him, and the one whom people put in charge of much, they will demand more than usual of him. (Luke 12:48)
- Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (Isaiah 5:20)

- You yourselves also as living stones are being built up a spiritual house for the purpose of a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 2:5)
- For it is contained in Scripture; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one

exercising faith in it will by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)

- It is to you, therefore, that he is precious, because you are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (1 Peter 2:7)
- And a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (1 Peter 2:8)
- Now Israel was dwelling in Shittim. Then the people started to have immoral relations with the daughters of Moab. (Numbers 25:1)
- And when Yehowah sent you out of Kadesh-barnea, saying; Go up and take possession of the land that I shall certainly give you! Then you behaved rebelliously against the order of Yehowah your God, and you did not exercise faith toward him and did not listen to his voice. (Deuteronomy 9:23)
- And he began to call out to the man of the true God that had come out of Judah, saying; This is what Yehowah has said, For the reason that you rebelled against the order of Yehowah and did not keep the commandment with which Yehowah your God commanded you. (1 Kings 13:21)

- But if you will not obey the voice of Yehowah and you will actually rebel against the order of Yehowah, the hand of Yehowah will certainly prove to be against you and your fathers. (1 Samuel 12:15)
- For rebelliousness is the same as the sin of divination, and pushing ahead presumptuously the same as using uncanny

- power and teraphim. Since you have rejected the word of Yehowah, he accordingly rejects you from being king. (1 Samuel 15:23)
- God will certainly hold them guilty, they will fall due to their own counsels. In the multitude of their transgressions let there be a dispersing of them, because they have rebelled against you.

 (Psalms 5:10)
- But if you people refuse and are actually rebellious, with a sword you will be eaten up, for the very mouth of Yehowah has spoken it. (Isaiah 1:20)
- But they themselves rebelled and made his Holy Spirit feel hurt. He now was changed into an enemy of theirs, he himself warred against them. (Isaiah 63:10)
- Now shortly I shall pour out my rage upon you, and I will bring my anger against you to its finish, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your detestable things. (Ezekiel 7:8)
- Like guards of the open field they have become against her on all sides, because she has rebelled even against me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 4:17)
- Samaria will be held guilty, for she is actually rebellious against her God. By the sword they will fall. Their own children will be dashed to pieces, and their pregnant women themselves will be ripped up. (Hosea 13:16)
