- However, become doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves with false reasoning. (**James 1:22**)
- But the one that did not understand and so did things deserving of strokes **will** be beaten with few. Indeed, everyone to whom much was given, much **will** be demanded of him, and the one whom people put in charge of much, they **will** demand more than usual of him. (**Luke 12:48**)
- Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (**Isaiah 5:20**)
- Woe to those wise in their own eyes and discreet even in front of their own faces! (**Isaiah 5:21**)
- Jesus said to them; Did **you** never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the builders rejected is the one that has become the chief cornerstone. From Yehowah this has come to be, and it is marvelous in our eyes? (**Matthew 21:42**)
- Coming to him as to a **living** stone, rejected, it is true, by men, but chosen, precious, with God. (**1 Peter 2:4**)
- **You** yourselves also as **living** stones are being built up a spiritual house for the purpose of a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. (**1 Peter 2:5**)
- For it is contained in Scripture; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one

- exercising faith in it **will** by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)
- It is to **you**, therefore, that he is precious, because **you** are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (1 Peter 2:7)
 - And a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (1 Peter 2:8)
 - Now Israel was dwelling in Shittim. Then the people started to have immoral relations with the daughters of Moab. (Numbers 25:1)
 - And when Yehowah sent **you out** of Kadesh-barnea, saying; Go up and take possession of the land that I shall certainly give **you**! Then **you** behaved rebelliously **against** the **order** of Yehowah **YOUR** God, and **you** did not exercise faith toward him and did not listen to his voice. (Deuteronomy 9:23)
 - And he **began** to call **out** to the **man** of the true God that had come **out** of Judah, saying; This is what Yehowah has said, For the reason that you rebelled **against** the **order** of Yehowah and did not **keep** the commandment with which Yehowah your God commanded you. (1 Kings 13:21)
 - And I proceeded to give them my **statutes**, and my **judicial decisions** I made known to them, in **order** that the **man** who **keeps doing** them might also **keep living** by them. (Ezekiel 20:11)
 - But they, the house of Israel, rebelled **against** me in the **wilderness**. In my **statutes** they did not **walk**, and my **judicial decisions** they rejected, which, should the **man keep doing**, he **will** also **keep living** by them. And my **Sabbaths** they **profaned** very much, so that I **promised** to **pour out** my fury upon them in the **wilderness**, in **order** to exterminate them. (Ezekiel 20:13)
 - But if **you will** not obey the voice of Yehowah and **you will** actually **rebel against** the **order** of Yehowah, the hand of Yehowah **will** certainly prove to be **against you** and **YOUR** fathers. (1 Samuel 12:15)
 - For rebelliousness is the same as the sin of divination, and pushing ahead presumptuously the same as using uncanny

- power and teraphim. Since you have rejected the word of Yehowah, he accordingly rejects you from being king. (**1 Samuel 15:23**)
- God **will** certainly hold them guilty, they **will** fall due to their own counsels. In the multitude of their transgressions let there be a dispersing of them, because they have rebelled **against** you. (**Psalms 5:10**)
 - But if **you** people refuse and are actually rebellious, with a sword **you will** be eaten up, for the very mouth of Yehowah has spoken it. (**Isaiah 1:20**)
 - But they themselves rebelled and made his Holy Spirit feel hurt. He now was changed into an enemy of theirs, he himself warred **against** them. (**Isaiah 63:10**)
 - Now shortly I shall **pour out** my **rage** upon you, and I **will bring** my **anger against** you to its **finish**, and I **will** judge you according to your ways and **bring** upon you all your detestable things. (**Ezekiel 7:8**)
 - Like guards of the open field they have become **against** her on all sides, because she has rebelled even **against** me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 4:17**)
 - Samaria **will** be held guilty, for she is actually rebellious **against** her God. By the sword they **will** fall. Their own children **will** be dashed to pieces, and their pregnant women themselves **will** be ripped up. (**Hosea 13:16**)
