- So **you**, also, when **you** have done all the things assigned to **you**, say; We are good-for-nothing slaves. What we have done is what we ought to have done. (**Luke 17:10**)
- For the Father judges no one at all, but he has committed all the judging to the Son. (**John 5:22**)
- And he has given him authority to do judging, because Son of man he is. (**John 5:27**)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; **You** know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (**Matthew 20:25**)
- This is not the way among **you**, but whoever wants to become great among **you** must be **your** minister. (**Matthew 20:26**)
- And whoever wants to be first among **you** must be **your** slave. (**Matthew 20:27**)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to **give** his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (**Matthew 20:28**)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones will quietly **bring** in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
- And Yehowah **your** God was the one who kept pushing them away from before **you**, and he dispossessed them on **your** account, and **you** took possession of their **land**, just as Yehowah **your** God had promised **you**. (**Joshua 23:5**)

- And you proceeded to **give** them kingdoms and peoples, and to apportion them piece by piece, so that they took possession of the **land** of Sihon, even the **land** of the king of Heshbon, and the **land** of Og the king of Bashan. (**Nehemiah 9:22**)
- Which covenant he concluded with Abraham, and his sworn statement to Isaac. (**Psalms 105:9**)
- In that day I **lifted** up my **hand** in an oath to them to **bring** them forth from the **land** of Egypt to a **land** that I had spied **out** for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the **lands**. (**Ezekiel 20:6**)
- **You** should absolutely destroy all the places where the nations whom **you** are dispossessing have served their gods, on the tall mountains and the **hills** and under every luxuriant **tree**. (**Deuteronomy 12:2**)
- And they too kept building for themselves high places and sacred pillars and sacred poles upon every high **hill** and under every luxuriant **tree**. (**1 Kings 14:23**)
- For their own errors and for the errors of their forefathers at the same time, Yehowah has said. Because they have made sacrificial smoke upon the mountains, and upon the **hills** they have reproached me, I will also measure **out** their wages first of all into their own bosom. (**Isaiah 65:7**)
- For long ago I broke your yoke to pieces, I tore your bands apart. But you said; I am not going to serve, for upon every high **hill** and under every luxuriant **tree** you were lying sprawled **out**, prostituting yourself. (**Jeremiah 2:20**)
- And they kept offending him with their high places, and with their graven images they kept inciting him to jealousy. (**Psalms 78:58**)
- Those who are working up passion among big **trees**, under every luxuriant **tree**, slaughtering the children in the torrent valleys under the clefts of the crags? (**Isaiah 57:5**)
- And **you** people will have to know that I am Yehowah, when their slain ones come to be in the midst of their dungy idols, all around their altars, upon every high **hill**, on all the tops of the mountains and under every luxuriant **tree** and under every **branchy** big **tree**,

- the place where they have offered a **restful** odor to all their dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 6:13**)
- And my bread that I had given to you, fine flour and oil and honey that I had had you eat, you also actually put it before them as a **restful** odor, and it continued to occur, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 16:19**)
 - And the houses of Jerusalem and the houses of the kings of Judah must become like the place of Topheth, unclean ones, that is, all the houses upon the roofs of which they made sacrificial smoke to all the army of the heavens and there was a **pouring out** of **drink offerings** to other gods. (**Jeremiah 19:13**)
 - In order that the sons of Israel may **bring** their **sacrifices**, which they are **sacrificing** in the open field, and they must **bring** them to Yehowah to the entrance of the tent of meeting to the priest, and they must sacrifice these as communion **sacrifices** to Yehowah. (**Leviticus 17:5**)
 - Watch **out** for yourself for fear you may be entrapped after them, after they have been annihilated from before you, and for fear you may inquire respecting their gods, saying; How was it these nations used to serve their gods? And I, yes, I, will do the same way. (**Deuteronomy 12:30**)
 - Upon a mountain high and **lifted** up you set your bed. There also you went up to offer sacrifice. (**Isaiah 57:7**)
 - Raise your eyes to the beaten paths and **see**. Where is it that you have not been raped? Alongside the ways you have sat for them, like an Arabian in the wilderness, and you keep polluting the **land** with your acts of prostitution and with your badness. (**Jeremiah 3:2**)
 - And after her doing all these things I kept saying that she should return even to me, but she did not return, and Judah kept looking at her own treacherous sister. (**Jeremiah 3:7**)
 - The sons are picking up sticks of wood, and the fathers are lighting the fire, and the wives are kneading flour dough in order to make sacrificial cakes to the queen of the heavens, and there is a **pouring out** of **drink offerings** to other gods for the purpose of offending me. (**Jeremiah 7:18**)

- **When their sons remember their altars and their sacred poles beside a luxuriant **tree**, upon the high **hills**. (Jeremiah 17:2)**
- **For the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah have proved to be mere doers of what was bad in my eyes, from their youth on up, for the sons of Israel are even offending me by the work of their hands, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 32:30)**
- **On the tops of the mountains they sacrifice, and on the **hills** they make sacrificial smoke, under massive **tree** and storax **tree** and big **tree**, because its shade is good. That is why **YOUR** daughters commit fornication and **YOUR** own daughters-in-law commit adultery. (Hosea 4:13)**
