Ezekiel 20:28... And I proceeded to bring them into the land that I had lifted up my hand in an oath to give them. When they got to see every exalted hill and every branchy tree, then they began sacrificing there their sacrifices and giving there their offensive offering, and presenting there their restful odors and pouring out there their drink offerings.

- So you, also, when you have done all the things assigned to you, say; We are good-for-nothing slaves. What we have done is what we ought to have done. (Luke 17:10)
- For the Father judges no one at all, but he has committed all the judging to the Son. (John 5:22)
- And he has given him authority to do judging, because Son of man he is. (John 5:27)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; You know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (Matthew 20:25)
- This is not the way among you, but whoever wants to become great among you must be your minister. (Matthew 20:26)
- And whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave. (Matthew 20:27)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (Matthew 20:28)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among You. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (2 Peter 2:1)
- And Yehowah Your God was the one who kept pushing them away from before You, and he dispossessed them on Your account, and You took possession of their land, just as Yehowah Your God had promised You. (Joshua 23:5)

- And you proceeded to give them kingdoms and peoples, and to apportion them piece by piece, so that they took possession of the land of Sihon, even the land of the king of Heshbon, and the land of Og the king of Bashan. (Nehemiah 9:22)
- Which covenant he concluded with Abraham, and his sworn statement to Isaac. (Psalms 105:9)
- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:6)
- You should absolutely destroy all the places where the nations whom you are dispossessing have served their gods, on the tall mountains and the hills and under every luxuriant tree.

 (Deuteronomy 12:2)
- And they too kept building for themselves high places and sacred pillars and sacred poles upon every high hill and under every luxuriant tree. (1 Kings 14:23)
- For their own errors and for the errors of their forefathers at the same time, Yehowah has said. Because they have made sacrificial smoke upon the mountains, and upon the hills they have reproached me, I will also measure out their wages first of all into their own bosom. (Isaiah 65:7)
- For long ago I broke your yoke to pieces, I tore your bands apart. But you said; I am not going to serve, for upon every high hill and under every luxuriant tree you were lying sprawled out, prostituting yourself. (Jeremiah 2:20)
- And they kept offending him with their high places, and with their graven images they kept inciting him to jealousy. (Psalms 78:58)
- Those who are working up passion among big trees, under every luxuriant tree, slaughtering the children in the torrent valleys under the clefts of the crags? (Isaiah 57:5)
- And you people will have to know that I am Yehowah, when their slain ones come to be in the midst of their dungy idols, all around their altars, upon every high hill, on all the tops of the mountains and under every luxuriant tree and under every branchy big tree,

- the place where they have offered a restful odor to all their dungy idols. (Ezekiel 6:13)
- And my bread that I had given to you, fine flour and oil and honey that I had had you eat, you also actually put it before them as a restful odor, and it continued to occur, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 16:19)
- And the houses of Jerusalem and the houses of the kings of Judah must become like the place of Topheth, unclean ones, that is, all the houses upon the roofs of which they made sacrificial smoke to all the army of the heavens and there was a pouring out of drink offerings to other gods. (Jeremiah 19:13)
- In order that the sons of Israel may bring their sacrifices, which they are sacrificing in the open field, and they must bring them to Yehowah to the entrance of the tent of meeting to the priest, and they must sacrifice these as communion sacrifices to Yehowah. (Leviticus 17:5)
- Watch out for yourself for fear you may be entrapped after them, after they have been annihilated from before you, and for fear you may inquire respecting their gods, saying; How was it these nations used to serve their gods? And I, yes, I, will do the same way. (Deuteronomy 12:30)
- Upon a mountain high and lifted up you set your bed. There also you went up to offer sacrifice. (Isaiah 57:7)
- Raise your eyes to the beaten paths and see. Where is it that you have not been raped? Alongside the ways you have sat for them, like an Arabian in the wilderness, and you keep polluting the land with your acts of prostitution and with your badness. (Jeremiah 3:2)
- And after her doing all these things I kept saying that she should return even to me, but she did not return, and Judah kept looking at her own treacherous sister. (Jeremiah 3:7)
- The sons are picking up sticks of wood, and the fathers are lighting the fire, and the wives are kneading flour dough in order to make sacrificial cakes to the queen of the heavens, and there is a pouring out of drink offerings to other gods for the purpose of offending me. (Jeremiah 7:18)

- When their sons remember their altars and their sacred poles beside a luxuriant tree, upon the high hills. (Jeremiah 17:2)
- For the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah have proved to be mere doers of what was bad in my eyes, from their youth on up, for the sons of Israel are even offending me by the work of their hands, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 32:30)
- On the tops of the mountains they sacrifice, and on the hills they make sacrificial smoke, under massive tree and storax tree and big tree, because its shade is good. That is why YOUR daughters commit fornication and YOUR own daughters-in-law commit adultery. (Hosea 4:13)
