Ezekiel 20:31. And in lifting up Your gifts by making Your sons pass through the fire, are You defiling yourselves for all Your dungy idols down till today? At the same time shall I myself be inquired of by You people, O house of Israel? As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah; I will not be inquired of by You.

- Later on the king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, the name of one of whom was Shiphrah and the name of the other Puah. (Exodus 1:15)
- Yes, he went so far as to say; When you help the Hebrew women to give birth and you do see them on the stool for childbirth, if it is a son, you must also put it to death, but if it is a daughter, it must also live. (Exodus 1:16)
- And you must say to Pharaoh, This is what Yehowah has said; Israel is my son, my firstborn. (Exodus 4:22)
- And I say to you; Send my son away that he may serve me. But should you refuse to send him away, here I am killing your son, your firstborn. (Exodus 4:23)
- Furthermore, they built the high places of Baal that are in the valley of the son of Hinnom, in order to make their sons and their daughters pass through the fire to Molech, a thing that I did not command them, neither did it come up into my heart to do this detestable thing, for the purpose of making Judah sin. (Jeremiah 32:35)
- There should not be found in you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, anyone who employs divination, a practicer of magic or anyone who looks for omens or a sorcerer. (Deuteronomy 18:10)
- And they would sacrifice their sons and their daughters to demons. (Psalms 106:37)
- And they have built the high places of Topheth, which is in the valley of the son of Hinnom, in order to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire, a thing that I had not commanded and that had not come up into my heart. (Jeremiah 7:31)

- And you used to see their disgusting things and their dungy idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, that were with them.

  (Deuteronomy 29:17)
- And he went acting very detestably by going after the dungy idols, the same as all that the Amorites had done, whom Yehowah drove out from before the sons of Israel. (1 Kings 21:26)
- And I went on to say to them; Throw away, each one of you, the disgusting things of his eyes, and with the dungy idols of Egypt do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah your God. (Ezekiel 20:7)
- Although Saul would inquire of Yehowah, Yehowah never answered him, either by dreams or by the Urim or by the prophets. (1 Samuel 28:6)
- At that time they will keep calling me, but I shall not answer, they will keep looking for me, but they will not find me. (Proverbs 1:28)
- And when you spread out your palms, I hide my eyes from you. Even though you make many prayers, I am not listening, with bloodshed your very hands have become filled. (Isaiah 1:15)
- And so it occurred that, just as he called and they did not listen, so they would call and I would not listen, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 7:13)
- As for the Avvites, they made Nibhaz and Tartak, and the Sepharvites were burning their sons in the fire to Adrammelech and Anammelech the gods of Sepharvaim. (2 Kings 17:31)
