

Ezekiel 20:40 For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, there is where they, the whole house of Israel in its entirety, will serve me, in the land. There I shall take pleasure in them, and there I shall require **YOUR** contributions and the firstfruits of **YOUR** presentations in all **YOUR** holy things.

- O Yehowah, who **will** be a guest in your tent? Who **will** reside in your **holy mountain**? (**Psalms 15:1**)
- He who is walking faultlessly and practicing righteousness and speaking the truth in his heart. (**Psalms 15:2**)
- He has not slandered with his tongue. To his companion he has done nothing bad, and no reproach has he taken up against his intimate acquaintance. (**Psalms 15:3**)
- In his eyes anyone contemptible is certainly rejected, but those fearing Yehowah he honors. He has sworn to what is bad for himself, and yet he does not alter. (**Psalms 15:4**)
- His money he has not given out on interest, and a bribe against the innocent one he has not taken. He that is doing these **things will** never be made to totter. (**Psalms 15:5**)
- Hey there, all **YOU** thirsty ones! Come to the water. And the ones that have no money! Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk even without money and without price. (**Isaiah 55:1**)
- Why do **YOU** people keep paying out money for what is not bread, and why is **YOUR** toil for what results in no satisfaction? Listen intently to me, and eat what is good, and let **YOUR** soul find its exquisite delight in fatness itself. (**Isaiah 55:2**)
- Incline **YOUR** ear and come to me. Listen, and **YOUR** soul **will** keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with **YOU** people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful. (**Isaiah 55:3**)
- Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (**Isaiah 55:4**)

- Look! A nation that you do not know you **will** call, and those of a nation who have not known you **will** run even to you, for the sake of Yehowah your God, and for the Holy One of **Israel**, because he **will** have beautified you. (**Isaiah 55:5**)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the **mountain** of the **house** of Yehowah **will** become firmly established above the top of the **mountains**, and it **will** certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it all the nations must stream. (**Isaiah 2:2**)
- And they **will** actually bring all **YOUR** brothers out of all the nations as a gift to Yehowah, on horses and in chariots and in covered wagons and on mules and on swift she-camels, up to my **holy mountain**, Jerusalem, Yehowah has said, just as when the sons of **Israel** bring the gift in a clean vessel into the **house** of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 66:20**)
- On the **mountain** of the **height** of **Israel** I shall transplant it, and it **will** certainly bear boughs and produce fruit and become a majestic cedar. And under it there **will** actually reside all the birds of every wing, in the shadow of its foliage they **will** reside. (**Ezekiel 17:23**)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the **mountain** of the **house** of Yehowah **will** become firmly established above the top of the **mountains**, and it **will** certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it peoples must stream. (**Micah 4:1**)
- And many nations **will** certainly go and say; Come, **you** people, and let us go up to the **mountain** of Yehowah and to the **house** of the God of Jacob, and he **will** instruct us about his ways, and we **will** walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law **will** go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (**Micah 4:2**)
- I **will** also bring them to my **holy mountain** and make them rejoice inside my **house** of prayer. Their **whole** burnt offerings and their sacrifices **will** be for acceptance upon my altar. For my own **house will** be called even a **house** of prayer for all the peoples. (**Isaiah 56:7**)
- And many peoples and mighty nations **will** actually come to seek Yehowah of armies in Jerusalem and to soften the face of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 8:22**)

- And the gift offering of Judah and of Jerusalem **will** actually be gratifying to Yehowah, as in the days of long ago and as in the years of antiquity. (**Malachi 3:4**)
- Consequently I entreat **you** by the compassions of God, brothers, to present **your** bodies a sacrifice living, **holy**, acceptable to God, a sacred service with **your** power of reason. (**Romans 12:1**)
- Through him let us always offer to God a sacrifice of praise, that is, the fruit of lips which make public declaration to his name. (**Hebrews 13:15**)
- They **will** not do any harm or cause any ruin in all my **holy mountain**, because the earth **will** certainly be filled with the knowledge of Yehowah as the waters are covering the very sea. (**Isaiah 11:9**)
- When you cry for aid your collection of **things will** not deliver you, but a wind **will** carry even all of them away. An exhalation **will take** them away, but the one taking refuge in me **will** inherit the **land** and **will take** possession of my **holy mountain**. (**Isaiah 57:13**)
- And they **will** certainly come and cry out joyfully on the **height** of Zion and become radiant over the goodness of Yehowah, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul **will** simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more **will** they languish again. (**Jeremiah 31:12**)
- And I **will** make them and the surroundings of my hill a blessing, and I **will** cause the pouring rain to descend in its time. Pouring rains of blessing there **will** prove to be. (**Ezekiel 34:26**)
- And they **will** complete the days. And it must occur on the eighth day and from then on that the priests **will** render upon the altar the **whole** burnt offerings of **you** people and **your** communion sacrifices, and I shall certainly find **pleasure** in **you**, is the **utterance** of the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah.
