Ezekiel 20:41... Because of the restful odor I shall take pleasure in you, when I bring you forth from the peoples and I actually collect you together from the lands to which you have been scattered, and I will be sanctified in you before the eyes of the nations.

- Do listen, O my people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will bear witness against you. I am God, your God. (Psalms 50:7)
- Why, you, you have hated discipline, and you keep throwing my words behind you. (Psalms 50:17)
- You sit and speak against your own brother, against the son of your mother you give away a fault. (Psalms 50:20)
- Understand this, please, you forgetters of God, that I may not tear you to pieces without there being any deliverer. (Psalms 50:22)
- And Yehowah began to smell a restful odor, and so Yehowah said in his heart; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the heart of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I have done. (Genesis 8:21)
- And go on walking in love, just as the Christ also loved YOU and delivered himself up for YOU as an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling odor. (Ephesians 5:2)
- However, I have all things in full and have an abundance. I am filled, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the things from You, a sweet-smelling odor, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God. (Philippians 4:18)
- And it must occur in that day that Yehowah will again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the remnant of his people who will remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (Isaiah 11:11)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I will bring them back to their pasture ground, and they will certainly be fruitful and become many. (Jeremiah 23:3)

- Therefore get out from among them, and separate yourselves, says Yehowah, and quit touching the unclean thing, and I will take you in. (2 Corinthians 6:17)
- And Yehowah of armies will become high through judgment, and the true God, the Holy One, will certainly sanctify himself through righteousness. (Isaiah 5:16)
- And I shall certainly magnify myself and sanctify myself and make myself known before the eyes of many nations, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 38:23)
- Then Moses said to Aaron; This is what Yehowah has spoken, saying, Among those near to me let me be sanctified, and before the face of all the people let me be glorified. And Aaron kept silent. (Leviticus 10:3)
- Every native should render up these in this way in presenting an offering made by fire, of a restful odor to Yehowah. (Numbers 15:13)
- And you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Sidon, and I shall certainly be glorified in the midst of you, and people will have to know that I am Yehowah when I execute acts of judgment in her and I am actually sanctified in her. (Ezekiel 28:22)
- And I shall certainly sanctify my great name, which was being profaned among the nations, which you profaned in the midst of them, and the nations will have to know that I am Yehowah, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, when I am sanctified among you before their eyes. (Ezekiel 36:23)
