

Ezekiel 20:41 • **Because of the restful odor I shall take pleasure in you, when I bring you forth from the peoples and I actually collect you together from the lands to which you have been scattered, and I will be sanctified in you before the eyes of the nations.**

[14] - References:

- Do listen, O my people, and I **will** speak, O Israel, and I **will** bear witness against you. I am God, your God. (**Psalms 50:7**)
- Why, you, you **have** hated discipline, and you keep throwing my words behind you. (**Psalms 50:17**)
- You sit and speak against your own brother, against the son of your mother you give away a fault. (**Psalms 50:20**)
- Understand this, please, **you** forgetters of God, that I may not tear **you** to pieces without there being any deliverer. (**Psalms 50:22**)
- And Yehowah began to smell a restful **odor**, and so Yehowah said in his heart; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the heart of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I **have** done. (**Genesis 8:21**)
- And go on walking in love, just as the Christ also loved **you** and delivered himself up for **you** as an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling **odor**. (**Ephesians 5:2**)
- However, I **have** all things in full and **have** an abundance. I am filled, now that I **have** received from Epaphroditus the things from **you**, a sweet-smelling **odor**, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God. (**Philippians 4:18**)
- And it must occur in that day that Yehowah **will** again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the remnant of his people who **will** remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (**Isaiah 11:11**)
- And I myself shall **collect together** the remnant of my sheep out of all the **lands** to which I had dispersed them, and I **will bring** them back to their pasture ground, and they **will** certainly be fruitful and become many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)

- Therefore get out from among them, and separate yourselves, says Yehowah, and quit touching the unclean thing, and I **will take you** in. (**2 Corinthians 6:17**)
- And Yehowah of armies **will** become high through judgment, and the true God, the Holy One, **will** certainly sanctify himself through righteousness. (**Isaiah 5:16**)
- And I shall certainly magnify myself and sanctify myself and make myself known **before** the **eyes** of many **nations**, and they **will have** to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 38:23**)
- Then Moses said to Aaron; This is what Yehowah has spoken, saying, Among those near to me let me be **sanctified**, and **before** the face of all the people let me be glorified. And Aaron kept silent. (**Leviticus 10:3**)
- Every native should render up these in this way in presenting an offering made by fire, of a restful **odor** to Yehowah. (**Numbers 15:13**)
- And you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Sidon, and I shall certainly be glorified in the midst of you, and people **will have** to know that I am Yehowah when I execute acts of judgment in her and I am **actually sanctified** in her. (**Ezekiel 28:22**)
- And I shall certainly sanctify my great name, which was being profaned among the **nations**, which **you** profaned in the midst of them, and the **nations will have** to know that I am Yehowah, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, when I am **sanctified** among **you before** their **eyes**. (**Ezekiel 36:23**)
