

Ezekiel 20:43 And **you** will certainly remember there **your** ways and all **your** dealings by which **you** defiled yourselves, and **you** will actually feel a loathing at **your** own faces because of all **your** bad things that **you** did.

[13] - References:

- Do **you** not know that **you** people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in **you**? (**1 Corinthians 3:16**)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God **will** destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple **you** people are. (**1 Corinthians 3:17**)
- Jesus said to them; Did **you** never read in the Scriptures: The stone that the builders rejected is the one that has become the chief cornerstone. From Yehowah this has come to be, and it is marvelous in our eyes? (**Matthew 21:42**)
- This is why I say to **you**, the kingdom of God **will** be taken from **you** and be given to a nation producing its fruits. (**Matthew 21:43**)
- Also, the person falling upon this stone **will** be shattered. As for anyone upon whom it falls, it **will** pulverize him. (**Matthew 21:44**)
- Coming to him as to a living stone, rejected, it is true, by men, but chosen, precious, with God. (**1 Peter 2:4**)
- **You** yourselves also as living stones are being built up a spiritual house for the purpose of a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. (**1 Peter 2:5**)
- For it is contained in Scripture; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it **will** by any means come to disappointment. (**1 Peter 2:6**)
- It is to **you**, therefore, that he is precious, because **you** are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (**1 Peter 2:7**)

- And, a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (1 Peter 2:8)
- And they will certainly confess their own error and the error of their fathers in their unfaithfulness when they behaved unfaithfully toward me, yes, even when they walked in opposition to me. (Leviticus 26:40)
- When you will have returned to me and kept my commandments and done them, though your dispersed people should happen to be at the end of the heavens, from there I shall collect them and certainly bring them to the place that I have chosen to have my name reside there. (Nehemiah 1:9)
- And you will certainly remember your ways and feel humiliated when you receive your sisters, the ones older than you as well as the ones younger than you, and I shall certainly give them to you as daughters, but not owing to your covenant. (Ezekiel 16:61)
- I shall go, I will return to my place until they bear their guilt, and they will certainly seek my face. When they are in sore straits, they will seek me. (Hosea 5:15)
- And your escaped ones will certainly remember me among the nations to which they will have been taken captive, because I have been broken up at their fornicating heart that has turned aside from me and at their eyes that are going in fornication after their dungy idols, and they will certainly feel a loathing in their faces at the bad things that they have done in all their detestable things. (Ezekiel 6:9)
- I have positively heard Ephraim bemoaning himself, You have corrected me, that I may be corrected, like a calf that has not been trained. Cause me to turn back, and I shall readily turn back, for you are Yehowah my God. (Jeremiah 31:18)
- But, look! There will certainly be left remaining in it an escaped company, those being brought forth. Sons and daughters, here they are! They are going forth to you people, and you will have to see their way and their dealings. And you will certainly be comforted over the calamity that I shall have brought upon Jerusalem, even all that I shall have brought upon her. (Ezekiel 14:22)

- And **you will** be bound to **remember your bad ways** and **your dealings** that were not good, and **you will** be bound to **feel a loathing** at **your own** person on account of **your** errors and on account of **your** detestable **things**. (**Ezekiel 36:31**)
- And they **will** no longer defile themselves with their dungy idols and with their disgusting **things** and with all their transgressions, and I shall **certainly** save them from all their dwelling places in which they have sinned, and I **will** cleanse them, and they must become my people, and I myself shall become their God. (**Ezekiel 37:23**)
- However, as regards my words and my regulations that I commanded my servants, the prophets, did they not catch up with **your** fathers? So they returned and said; According to what Yehowah of armies had in mind to do to us, according to our **ways** and according to our **dealings**, that is how he has done with us. (**Zechariah 1:6**)
