- Son of man, in what way does the vine tree happen to be different from every other tree, the shoot, that has come to be among the trees of the forest? (Ezekiel 15:2)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said;
 Just like the vine tree among the trees of the forest, that I have
 given to the fire as fuel, so I have given the inhabitants of
 Jerusalem. (Ezekiel 15:6)
