Ezekiel 20:47... And you must say to the forest of the south, Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am setting a fire ablaze against you, and it must devour in you every still-moist tree and every dry tree. The kindling flame will not be extinguished, and by it all faces must be scorched from the south to the north.

- At this Judah said to his brothers; What profit would there be in case we killed our brother and did cover over his blood? (Genesis 37:26)
- Come and let us sell him to the Ishmaelites, and do not let our hand be upon him. After all, he is our brother, our flesh. So they listened to their brother. (Genesis 37:27)
- However, they took Joseph's long garment and slaughtered a male goat and repeatedly dipped the long garment in the blood. (Genesis 37:31)
- After that they sent the long striped garment and had it brought to their father and said; This is what we found. Examine, please, whether it is your son's long garment or not. (Genesis 37:32)
- And he went examining it and exclaimed; It is my son's long garment! A vicious wild beast must have devoured him! Joseph is surely torn to pieces! (Genesis 37:33)
- Well, they caught sight of him from a distance, and before he could get close by them they began plotting cunningly against him to put him to death. (Genesis 37:18)
- So they said to one another; Look! Here comes that dreamer. (Genesis 37:19)
- For a fire has been ignited in my anger and it will burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it will consume the earth and its produce and will set ablaze the foundations of mountains.

  (Deuteronomy 32:22)
- I will also hold an accounting against you according to the fruitage of your dealings, is the utterance of Yehowah. And I will set a fire ablaze in her forest, and it will certainly devour all the things round about her. (Jeremiah 21:14)

- And all the trees of the field will have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have abased the high tree, have put on high the low tree, have dried up the still-moist tree and have made the dry tree blossom. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken and have done it. (Ezekiel 17:24)
- Because if they do these things when the tree is moist, what will occur when it is withered? (Luke 23:31)
- And they will actually go forth and look upon the carcasses of the men that were transgressing against me, for the very worms upon them will not die and their fire itself will not be extinguished, and they must become something repulsive to all flesh. (Isaiah 66:24)
- His winnowing shovel is in his hand, and he will completely clean up his threshing floor, and will gather his wheat into the storehouse, but the chaff he will burn up with fire that cannot be put out. (Matthew 3:12)
- In order that I may actually cut off from you righteous one and wicked one, therefore my sword will go forth from its sheath against all flesh from south to north. (Ezekiel 21:4)
- The voice of Yehowah itself makes the hinds writhe with birth pains and strips bare the forests. And in his temple each one is saying; Glory! (Psalms 29:9)
- And the vigorous man will certainly become tow, and the product of his activity a spark, and both of them will certainly go up in flames at the same time, with no one to do the extinguishing. (Isaiah 1:31)
- For wickedness has become aflame just like a fire, thornbushes and weeds it will eat up. And it will catch fire in the thickets of the forest, and they will be borne aloft as the billowing of smoke. (Isaiah 9:18)
- By night or by day it will not be extinguished, to time indefinite its smoke will keep ascending. From generation to generation she will be parched, forever and ever no one will be passing across her. (Isaiah 34:10)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My anger and my rage are being poured forth upon this place, upon mankind and upon domestic animal, and upon the

- tree of the field and upon the fruitage of the ground, and it must burn, and it will not be extinguished. (Jeremiah 7:20)
- But if you will not obey me by sanctifying the Sabbath day and not carrying a load, but there is a coming in with it through the gates of Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, I will also set a fire ablaze in her gates, and it will certainly devour the dwelling towers of Jerusalem and will not be extinguished. (Jeremiah 17:27)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Just like the vine tree among the trees of the forest, that I have given to the fire as fuel, so I have given the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (Ezekiel 15:6)
- And I will express my ardor against you, and they must take action against you in rage. Your nose and your ears they will remove, and the remainder of you will fall even by the sword. Your sons and your daughters they themselves will take, and the remainder of you will be devoured by the fire. (Ezekiel 23:25)
- And a sword will certainly whirl about in his cities and make an end of his bars and devour because of their counsels. (Hosea 11:6)
- Search for Yehowah, and keep living, that he may not become operative just like fire, O house of Joseph, and it may not actually devour, and Bethel may not be with no one to extinguish it. (Amos 5:6)
