Ezekiel 20:6" In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands.

- Will two walk together unless they have met by appointment? (Amos 3:3)
- Will a lion roar in the forest when it has no prey? Will a young maned lion give forth its voice from its hiding place if it has caught nothing at all? (Amos 3:4)
- Will a bird fall into a trap on the earth when there is no snare for it? Does a trap go up from the ground when it has absolutely caught nothing? (Amos 3:5)
- If a horn is blown in a city, do not also the people themselves tremble? If a calamity occurs in the city, is it not also Yehowah who has acted? (Amos 3:6)
- For the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will not do a thing unless he has revealed his confidential matter to his servants the prophets. (Amos 3:7)
- There is a lion that has roared! Who will not be afraid? The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself has spoken! Who will not prophesy? (Amos 3:8)
- For when God made his promise to Abraham, since he could not swear by anyone greater, he swore by himself. (Hebrews 6:13)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a land good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (Exodus 3:8)
- For Yehowah your God is bringing you into a good land, a land of torrent valleys of water, springs and watery deeps issuing forth in the valley plain and in the mountainous region. (Deuteronomy 8:7)

- For the sons of Israel had walked forty years in the wilderness, until all the nation of the men of war who came out of Egypt that did not listen to the voice of Yehowah had come to its finish, to whom Yehowah swore that he would never let them see the land that Yehowah had sworn to their forefathers to give to us, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Joshua 5:6)
- For the purpose of carrying out the oath that I swore to YOUR forefathers, to give them the land flowing with milk and honey, as in this day. And I proceeded to answer and say; Amen, O Yehowah. (Jeremiah 11:5)
- In time you gave them this land that you swore to their forefathers to give to them, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Jeremiah 32:22)
- Pretty for loftiness, the exultation of the whole earth, is Mount Zion on the remote sides of the north, the town of the grand King. (Psalms 48:2)
- He will also actually enter into the land of the Decoration, and there will be many lands that will be made to stumble. But these are the ones that will escape out of his hand, Edom and Moab and the main part of the sons of Ammon. (Daniel 11:41)
- And I proceeded tempestuously to hurl them throughout all the nations that they had not known, and the land itself has been left desolate behind them, with no one passing through and with no one returning, and they proceeded to make the desirable land an object of astonishment. (Zechariah 7:14)
- Hence I said to You; You, for Your part, will take possession of their ground, and I, for my part, shall give it to You to take possession of it, a land flowing with milk and honey. Yehowah YOUR God I am, who have divided YOU off from the peoples. (Leviticus 20:24)
- And what the land is, whether it is fat or lean, whether there are trees in it or not. And you must show yourselves courageous and take some of the fruitage of the land. Now the days were the days of the first ripe fruits of the grapes. (Numbers 13:20)
- Yehowah hated us that he brought us out of the land of Egypt to give us into the hand of the Amorites, to annihilate us. (Deuteronomy 1:27)

- Let me pass over, please, and see the good land that is across the Jordan, this good mountainous region and Lebanon. (Deuteronomy 3:25)
- A land of wheat and barley and vines and figs and pomegranates, a land of oil olives and honey. (Deuteronomy 8:8)
- And in order that you may lengthen your days on the soil that Yehowah swore to your forefathers to give to them and their seed, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Deuteronomy 11:9)
- Then he brought us to this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Deuteronomy 26:9)
- For I shall bring them to the ground that I have sworn about to their forefathers, which flows with milk and honey, and they will certainly eat and be satisfied and grow fat and turn to other gods, and they will indeed serve them and treat me with disrespect and break my covenant. (Deuteronomy 31:20)
- Forty years old I was when Moses the servant of Yehowah sent me out of Kadesh-barnea to spy out the land, and I came bringing him back word just as it was in my heart. (Joshua 14:7)
- When you come in, you will come to an unsuspecting people, and the land is quite wide, for God has given it into your hand, a place where there is no lack of any sort of thing that is in the earth. (Judges 18:10)
- And I shall certainly appoint a place for my people Israel and plant them, and they will indeed reside where they are, and no more will they be disturbed, and the sons of unrighteousness will not afflict them again as they did at the first. (2 Samuel 7:10)
- And they went capturing fortified cities and a fat soil and taking in possession houses full of all good things, cisterns hewn out, vineyards and olive groves and trees for food in abundance, and they began to eat and to be satisfied and to grow fat and to luxuriate in your great goodness. (Nehemiah 9:25)
- And they got to contemning the desirable land, they had no faith in his word. (Psalms 106:24)
- Beat yourselves upon the breasts in lamentation over the desirable fields, over the fruit-bearing vine. (Isaiah 32:12)

- And I myself have said; O how I proceeded to place you among the sons and to give you the desirable land, the hereditary possession of the ornament of the armies of the nations! And I further said, My Father! You people will call out to me, and from following me you people will not turn back. (Jeremiah 3:19)
- Which I commanded YOUR forefathers in the day of my bringing them out of the land of Egypt, out of the furnace of iron, saying, Obey my voice, and YOU must do things according to all that I command YOU, and YOU will certainly become my people and I myself shall become YOUR God. (Jeremiah 11:4)
- And I proceeded to bring them into the land that I had lifted up my hand in an oath to give them. When they got to see every exalted hill and every branchy tree, then they began sacrificing there their sacrifices and giving there their offensive offering, and presenting there their restful odors and pouring out there their drink offerings. (Ezekiel 20:28)
- And out of one of them there came forth another horn, a small one, and it kept getting very much greater toward the south and toward the sunrising and toward the Decoration. (Daniel 8:9)
- And the one coming against him will do according to his will, and there will be no one standing before him. And he will stand in the land of the Decoration, and there will be extermination in his hand. (Daniel 11:16)
